Overall easier site to run the meet; the pool expense was about \$7,000.00, while VMAC is about \$3,000.00; Swimmers like the change of venue for Oahu swimmers; housing is less expensive; Short Course pool is superior; UH does not have athlete space on the deck level; The leak put extra stress on pool staff.

- c. Possible alternative meet site for Sectional swimmers;
  - .When: during spring break? During the week; decision on Federal Way Sectional will be made on March 9.
  - d. NTV uploading is complete; some 18 year olds did not have APT requirement completed
  - e. Time standards: 10 & U 400IM and 500 Free use 11-12 standards for those event.
  - f. OME does not show individuals and times, so does not show aggregate times for proving time standard eligibility. How do we deal with those times?
    - .OME is set for LC AG Champs to be held at VMAC.
    - i.AR from meet can gather the names for relays in email prior to the meet.
    - ii. Committee is looking at not entering the time in SWIMS if the relay does not meet the entry standard.
