## County of Honolulu Expanded Tier 3 Reopening of Organized Sports

On March 18, 2021 a virtual meeting with the County of Honolulu Department of Parks and Recreation (HDPR) Director Laura Thielen was held. The meeting was open to all concerning permitting for organized sports.



The virtual meeting was held in connection with Governor David Ige's approval of Mayor Rick Blangiardi plan to implement an expanded Tier 3 allowing organized sports to resume practice and play. Director Thielen explained that Governor Ige and the Department of Health specified the opening of organized sports follow specific guidelines. The HDPR has provided the following links to help with the permit applications, general information, and additional terms and conditions to resume outdoor sports.

Director Thielen emphasized teams should contact the facilities that they want to use and work with staff to complete and obtain a facility use permit. Requirements include a plan on identifying safely bringing teams in to train, having a contact tracing procedure, and identifying a person who will be responsible to help with contact tracing. Contact tracing requirements are found in the attached links above. Teams will also need to administer "touchless" temperature checks, hygiene supplies to sanitize contact surfaces, and hand sanitizers.
