General Information:

<u>Any swimmer</u> on a team in the Central Iowa Swim Conference may compete in this meet. You do not have to qualify for this swim meet. The Central Iowa Swim Conference teams are: Ankeny, Ballard, Grinnell, Knoxville, Marshalltown, Newton, Pella, Walnut Creek and Waukee. The difference for this Conference meet is that all the teams will compete instead of 2-3 teams like our regular season meets. One other difference is this meet is scored and swimmer can achieve a medal 1st-3rd instead of a ribbon.

The 25 Yard, 10 lane Natatorium is located on the Grinnell College Campus. Parking is available in the parking lot across the street to the South and also the Tennis Court parking lot to the East across the rail road tracks. Please park in visitor parking spots only as we are not responsible for any parking tickets that you may receive while attending our swim meets. There is plenty of seating on our bleachers and also room for chairs if you prefer to bring your own.

Medals are given for 1st-3rd place and ribbons will be given to those earning 4th-8th place. Coaches will be given awards at the end of the meet. Awards will not be mailed out to teams.

Locker rooms:

There are locker rooms available for use. They are located down the hallway off the pool deck. Do not leave items unattended in the locker room areas.

Conference Swim Meet T-shirts:
