

Questions to ask

- What meets are coming?
- What meets should I go to/qualify for?
- How do I sign up for events?

What meets are coming?

- Go to the "EVENTS" tab at our web site and you will see a list of all the meets that ACAC is offering over the current season.
- Within this window you can scroll down and see WHEN and WHERE the meets might be.



What meets should I go to/qualify for?


- Generally ACAC tries to offer 2 meets a month.
- The staff would like all athletes to compete in as many meets as they are available for.
- If you are unsure if you qualify or should go to a meet don't be afraid to contact the coach of your son/daughters group. We are here to help with decisions like that. A meet may not fit your child's goals at the time. **Get a plan with your coach!**
- Some meets have qualifying standards others don't.
 You can figure this out by viewing the meet information. See next slide.


Meet Information PDF

- Things to Watch For -

- Time Every meet has a time format. This means it will list out what time your child's age group will swim (warm-ups and meet start).
- Qualifying Standards If there are any it will give a standard time needed to enter the meet.
- Entry Requirements This will tell you how many events your child can enter in the whole meet or events per day (you are not expected to do the max amount. See your coach on event selection).
- Scoring and Awards Different meets award athletes different awards. IE: trophy, ribbons or nothing some times.
- Warm-Up Times Always gives an idea of what time warm-ups will be.
- Session Formats Gives a break down of what events are on what day and time they run.





Athlete Sign Up Page


- You will then be prompted to an athlete sign up page.

Things to Notice While Picking Events

- Notice in the "Time" window above there is a "NT" in the window.
 This means your athlete has yet to compete in this event and does not have a time.
- When picking events you will only be able to pick highlighted event's in the windows (you don't have the quall time to pick the darkened events or are to old)
- If you pick too many events the system will not allow you to pick the additional event. It has limits on what you are able to pick already so don't be worried about picking to many events.
- Notice the days events are offered. Then the session events are offered. The sessions should match the meet PDF we discussed in slide 6.

Now You Have Picked Events

- Once you have picked your events by highlighting the box on the far left hand side indicated in slide 11 (E1).
- Go to the bottom of the page and select "Save Changes"





Picked Events

- You will then see the window below.
- It should list the events you have picked and the date you last updated it.


- You have now done all the work you needed to to get your child signed up for the meet.
- It is now up to the coaches to move the process along.

Coaches Job In Picked Events

- Once you have picked your events and saved them the coach will then go in and either approave or reject events.
 For the most part all events are approaved.
- Reasons for rejecting events could be many. Contact your coach to find out why they may have rejected an event you picked. A lot of times they want you to do a different event or they feel you are signed up for to many. At any rate there should still be a discussion with your coach.
- Declared athletes but not signed up yet. Every so often an athlete will sign up but not pick events. The coach will pick them for you if you wait until the night of and they are not picked yet.

Results

 Once a meet is swam the results are then uploaded in the team unify where you can view your times under the "My Account" tab and then "My Meet Results."



 Your best time will also be displayed in the "Time" column when you go to sign up for another meet.
