IASI SANCTION: IA-25-88. Held under the sanction of USA Swimming and Iowa Swimming,

Inc. (IASI).

RULES: Current USA Swimming and technical and administrative rules and IASI

policies and procedures will govern this meet.

All applicable adults participating in or associated with the meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA

Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP is a condition of

participation in the conduct of this competition.

A quality control system has been implemented to ensure that individuals who are ineligible for participation are unable to participate in this competition. Additionally, all adult members of USA Swimming who have not completed their Athlete Protection Training will not be able to participate at this meet.

FACILITY: The host will ensure the required course dimensions.

The Dubuque Community Schools Aquatic Center features:

- A pool which is 40 yds. long by 25 yards wide with a moveable bulkhead
- Racing course will be set so that there are eight nine-foot wide 25-yard lanes turning at the bulkhead, with an additional five 25-yard seven-foot wide lanes for warm-up and cool-down
- 6" deep at the starting end and 6'7" deep at the turn end
- 8 & Under 25 yd. events will start from the bulkhead
- Spectrum starting blocks that include wedges and side rails
- Daktronics Timing System with eight-foot touch pads, one button back up, and two timers w/stopwatch back-up
- Daktronics Eight-Lane Timing Scoreboard
- Parking available around the Aquatic Center
- The meet will be live-streamed via the DASH website. Details to follow.

COACHES:

Only currently registered USA Swimming coach members will be permitted on deck in designated areas. Each coach must sign the Coaches Meet Sign-In (APP-29).

WARM-UPS:

The IASI mandatory warm-up procedure will be followed in accordance with the IASI Policies and Procedures. The pool will be cleared 10 minutes prior to competition.

WARM-UPS:

All swimmers must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. Any swimmer without a coach shall report to the Meet Referee prior to his or her warm-up. The referee may assist the swimmer in making arrangements for such supervision, but it is the swimmer's responsibility to ensure such arrangements are made prior to the start of the meet.

MEDICAL:

Lifeguards will supervise the warmup pool during competition, but not during warm-ups. First Aid and AED devices are available on the pool deck.

RACING STARTS:

All swimmers entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water without the use of a backstroke ledge. When unaccompanied by a member coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS:

- 1. Swimmers must be currently registered as athlete members of USA Swimming in order to compete in this meet.
- 2. Swimmers may enter up to four (4) individual events.
- 3. Seed times must be submitted for a 25 yd. course. Converted times are not allowed. If a swimmer does not have a time for an event, please enter NT.
- 4. Swimmers must enter the age group as of June 7, 2025.

ENTRY FEES & SUBMISSION:

1. Individual events: \$7.00 per event.

- 2. IASI swimmer surcharge: \$6.00 per swimmer.
- 3. Manual entries (for teams entering more than five swimmers): \$2.00 per swimmer.
- 4. The entry fee for each outreach swimmer who qualifies for LSC benefits is \$5.00 and covers all individual events swum by an outreach swimmer.

Electronic entries must be submitted in a format compatible with HY-TEK Meet Manager software. All other entries require manual input and must be submitted on the IASI Meet Entry Form (APP-7).

Clubs entering outreach swimmers should only provide the number of outreach swimmers and the number of events being swum by the outreach swimmers to the host club. The names of the outreach swimmers are not to be provided to the host club.

Submit entries along with the appropriate IASI Financial Sheet (APP-8.1). If submitting electronic entries, also send a hardcopy of the entries with the entry fees and financial sheet.

Payment shall be by check made payable to Dubuque Area Swimmin' Hurricanes. All entry fees, including IASI swimmer surcharge fee, should be combined on one check. The host club reserves the right to require payment by money order or cashier's check. Entry fees are non-refundable; IASI swimmer surcharge fees will be refunded only if the entire meet is canceled.

ENTRY DATES AND DEADLINES:

- 1. Entries will be accepted only from IASI teams beginning on Monday, May 5, 2025, 10:00 a.m. CT.
- 2. All other entries will be accepted beginning on Monday, May 12, 2025, 10:00 a.m. CT.
- 3. Handwritten entries, along with entry fees and financial sheet, must be received no later than Noon CT, Friday, May 30, 2025.
- 4. Electronic entries must be received no later than Noon, Monday, June 2, 2025. A hardcopy of the entries, along with entry fees and financial sheet, must be received by Noon CT, Wednesday, June 4, 2025 OR arrangements made to pay at the meet. Failure to submit the hardcopy and fees by this deadline, or make arrangements, will result in entries being scratched.
- 5. Entries *will not* be accepted by phone or fax.

LATE ENTRIES: Late entries WILL NOT be accepted.

SWIMMERS WITH DISABILITIES:

Swimmers with disabilities are encouraged to compete. The Information Form for Adapted Competitive Swimmers (APP-21) indicating limitations and requested modifications should be completed and attached to the meet entries. Modifications will be determined by the referee. The swimmer (or swimmer's coach) is responsible for providing any equipment or assistants required. See Article 105 of USA Swimming Rules and Regulations.

MEET COMMITTEE: A meet committee consisting of the Meet Director, referee, a Coach Representative, an Athlete Representative, and a certified official acting at large will be established. The committee shall serve as the meet jury to consider any administrative protests filed at the meet. Protests against judgment decisions can only be considered by the Referee and the Referee's decision is final.

MEET OPERATION:

- 1. There will be NO Clerk of Course, however, volunteers will be stationed behind the starting area to help guide swimmers to their lanes.
- 2. Events may be combined to facilitate meet operation and separated later for results and scoring.
- 3. Deck changes are prohibited.
- 4. The host is not responsible for providing rest for swimmers between events. Breaks WILL NOT be taken for swimmers who are swimming back to back or close races. Plan accordingly.
- 5. The USA Swimming mobile application is acceptable proof of membership in USA Swimming. Coaches and Officials must produce proof of membership in USA Swimming immediately upon request by the Referee or his/her delegate or leave the pool deck.
- 6. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
- 7. Events will be pre-seeded.

SCORING: None

AWARDS: Individual Events 1st - 8th Ribbons for 11 & Younger events only

SCRATCHES: The IASI scratch rule is in effect.

NO SHOWS will be considered as an event contested and count toward the total.

USA SWIMMING REGISTRATION:

All swimmers must be members of USA Swimming. The meet host will notify teams if they have entered swimmers whose memberships cannot be verified through pre-meet reconciliation. Those swimmers must prove membership to the meet host by either (i) showing the athlete's member card from the USA Swimming mobile app or website, or (ii) demonstrating that the athlete appears on a current club roster report produced from SWIMS 3.0. Screenshots of the athlete's member card is NOT acceptable proof of membership. Any swimmer who fails to prove membership no later than 10 minutes prior to warm-ups for

the first session in which they are entered to compete will not be permitted to compete, forfeits their entry fees, and will be administratively disqualified from the entire meet.

CAMERAS: USE OF AUDIO OR VISUAL RECORDING DEVICES, INCLUDING

CELL PHONES, IS NOT PERMITTED AT ANY TIME IN CHANGING

AREAS, RESTROOMS, OR LOCKER ROOMS.

NO TOBACCO OR ALCOHOL:

ALL Dubuque Community School District property, including Hempstead High School, are "Tobacco Free" areas. The use of any tobacco products or alcohol is prohibited.

IMAGE RELEASE:

Participants consent to be photographed/filmed by any authorized photographer(s) and/or network(s) of IASI and/or the host club under conditions determined by the host club, and authorize the use of names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during or after the event to promote swimming. No awards received in this competition may be used for trade or financial gain.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION: <u>Programs</u>. Printed programs WILL NOT be sold at the meet. Programs will be posted on-line under the "meet landing page" of the TeamDASH website and sent to each entering for teams to disseminate to their families by 8 p.m., Thursday, June 6, 2025. Each team will receive a copy of the program in the coaches' packet. Each volunteer official will receive a complimentary program.

Results. Electronic results will be provided to all teams participating in the meet. Final results will be posted on the IASI and DASH websites. A hardcopy of the final results may be requested on the IASI Financial Sheet for an additional \$5.00.

Concessions. A light concession stand will be available.

Spectator information. No admission fee for spectators. Free parking is available.

INDEMNITY: In granting this approval it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming and IASI shall be free and held harmless from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.
