<u>Dubuque Area Swimmin' Hurricanes</u> <u>Code of Conduct for a Coach</u>

The purpose of this code of conduct for coaches is to establish common expectations for all members of the coaching staff of the club. It is to be used as a guide to promote a positive team environment and good sportsmanship.

Respectful communication:

- Treating everyone with courtesy and dignity, avoiding abusive language
- Respect officials and their judgment and abide by the rules of the event.
- Treat opposing coaches, participants, and spectators with respect.

Positive reinforcement:

- Focusing on constructive feedback and encouragement rather than humiliation or belittlement.
- Instruct participants in sportsmanship and promote the expectation that they display good sportsmanship.
- Coach in a positive manner and do not use derogatory comments or abusive language.
- Win with humility and lose with dignity.

Fairness and impartiality:

- Selecting swimmers based on merit, treating all athletes equally.
- Set a good example of respect and sportsmanship for participants and fans to follow.
- Treat every athlete fairly, justly, impartially, intelligently, and with sensitivity.
- Always place the well-being, health, and safety of swimmers above all other considerations, including developing performance.

Adherence to rules:

- Following all established rules and regulations of the sport.
- At all times, adhere to USA Swimming's rules, DASH's team policies and code of conduct.
- Always maintain a professional separation between coach and athlete.

Maintaining confidentiality:

Protecting sensitive information about athletes.

Professional development:

- Continuously improving coaching skills and knowledge.
- Act and dress with professionalism and dignity in a manner suitable to his/her profession.
- Continue to seek and maintain their own professional development in all areas in relation to coaching and teaching children.

Conflict resolution:

Addressing issues constructively and appropriately following DASH's policies

Reporting misconduct:

• Reporting any suspected abuse or unethical behavior per USA Swimming Safe Sport policies and guidelines.

Any complaints of a coach violating this code of conduct will be brought to the attention of his/her supervisor and/or the club's board of directors.
