# ISI Officials Certification / Recertification Requirements and Discrepancies

Requirements are shown from four sources:

- 1. USA Swimming minimum requirements.
- 2. Officials Committee requirements document, published on the Officials website
- 3. ISI Officials Apprentice Forms
- 4. Existing ISI P&P, Section G, published on the ISI website.

An abridged summary of the USA Swimming minimum requirements is given. Differences with ISI documentation are then noted. Discrepancies between ISI documents are <u>underlined</u>. Any item in ISI documentation that does not meet the USA minimum requirement is **shown in bold red**.

Discrepancies between items listed in 2 and 3 need to be resolved. Certification requirements in Section G are proposed for deletion at a future HoD meeting, so no action on 4 is proposed at this time.

### Certification

# Stroke and Turn Judge

- 1. Attend ST clinic. Pass online ST test. 4 apprentice sessions with 2 mentors with min. 1 year certification (cannot make a disqualification during those sessions). Pass Level II background check and complete APT. Must certify within 1 year of clinic. Must work at least 4 sessions per year as ST or higher.
- 2. Pass online test if not already a certified AO. At least 2 apprentice sessions must be at ISI meets.
  - a. Admin officials were previously required to take the online ST test. That requirement was removed so the ST requirement needs be updated to reflect this.
- 3. At least 2 apprentice sessions must be at ISI sanctioned meets.
  - a. Part b of Apprentice Form is confusing, states "you cannot make a disqualification within 1 year".
    Recommend re-wording to say that apprentice sessions must be completed within 1 year of training class.
- 4. Pay \$5 initial certification fee. Perform on-the-deck apprenticeship for a minimum of four sessions with a certified official.
  - a. We no longer charge the \$5 fee.

#### Chief Judge

- 1. Must have minimum 1 year experience as a certified ST.
- 2. Not documented.
  - a. Unofficial policy has been that LSC CJ certification was given by the Officials Chair at the recommendation of a MR, from a meet where an official has worked the CJ position.
  - b. It was requested at the Officials General Meeting held on 10/7/18 that we add formal CJ requirements to the Officials Committee requirements document.
- 3. No apprentice form.
  - a. A place for a CJ mentor form was bookmarked on the Officials website.
- 4. Not documented.

### Admin Official

- 1. Attend Admin clinic. Pass online AO test. 2 apprentice sessions with a certified AO, AR or Referee with min. 1 year certification. Pass Level II background check and complete APT. Must work at least 4 sessions per year, with at least 1 as AO or higher. Other sessions can be personnel supervised by AO, such as CC, timing system, etc.
- 2. If not already a ST, pass the online ST test. Pass online AO and CC tests. 4 apprentice sessions with a certified official with at least 1 year Admin certification. All meets must be ISI meets. Must certify within 1 year of clinic. Must work at least 4 sessions per year, with at least 2 as AO or higher.
  - a. Requirement for AO to pass ST test was removed by Officials Committee.

- 3. <u>Does not mention the ST test</u>. Pass online AO and CC tests. 4 apprentice sessions with <u>2 mentors</u> with at least 1 year certification as AO or AR. No more than 2 apprentice sessions at non-ISI meets.
  - a. Form appears to say that apprenticing must be completed within 60 days.
- 4. <u>If not already ST, pay \$5 fee and pass online ST test</u>. Pass online AO and CC tests. 2 apprentice sessions with a certified official with at least 1 year Admin certification. Must certify within 1 year of clinic. Must work at least 4 sessions per year, with at least 2 as AO or higher.

### <u>Starter</u>

- 1. Must have worked a minimum of 5 sessions as a certified ST. Attend SR clinic. Pass online SR test. 5 apprentice sessions at 2 different meets with 2 different mentors. Must work at least 4 sessions per year as SR or higher.
- Must have minimum 6 months experience as a certified ST, and worked a minimum of 10 sessions. No clinic is mentioned. 5 apprentice sessions with 2 mentors (does not mention 2 meets). Final apprentice session with N2 or N3 mentor.
  - a. Have we ever held SR clinics?
- 3. <u>Must have worked 4 sessions</u> as a certified <u>ST</u>. No clinic is mentioned. 5 apprentice sessions with 2 mentors (does not mention 2 meets). Final apprentice session with N2 or N3 mentor. <u>No more than 2 apprentice</u> sessions at non-ISI meets.
- 4. <u>Must have worked 2 sessions as a certified ST</u>. No clinic is mentioned. 5 apprentice sessions (does not mention 2 mentors or 2 meets).

USA Swimming minimum requirements and current Section G do not mention DR, AR or MR, just Referee.

# <u>Referee</u>

- 1. Attend referee clinic. Must be certified as ST *or* SR for minimum of 1 year. Pass online tests for ST, TJ, CC, Admin and Referee within past 24 months. 6 apprentice sessions at min. 3 meets with at least 2 mentors. Must work at least 6 sessions per year as SR or higher with at least 1 session as Referee.
- 4. Must be certified ST and SR for minimum 1 year. Pass online CC, Admin and Referee tests. 1 of the 6 apprentice sessions must be in the Admin position. Work at least 6 sessions per year with at least 1 as Referee.

#### Deck Referee

- 2. No clinic is mentioned. Must be certified as ST *and* SR for minimum of 1 year. Pass online Referee test. Final apprentice session must be with N2 or N3 certified referee. Work a minimum or 4 sessions per year as DR, AR or MR.
  - a. Have we ever held referee clinics?
- 3. No clinic is mentioned. Must be certified as ST *and* SR for minimum of 1 year. Pass online Referee test. Final apprentice session must be with N2 or N3 certified referee. No more than 2 apprentice sessions at non-ISI meets.

# Admin Referee

- 2. **No clinic is mentioned**. <u>Must be certified as ST, SR and DR</u>. Pass online AR test. Work a minimum of **4 sessions** per year as DR, AR or MR.
  - a. Recommend AR should pass CC test, like AO.
- 3. **No clinic is mentioned**. <u>Must have worked a minimum 6 sessions as DR</u>. Pass online AR test. <u>Final apprentice session with N2 or N3 AR or N2 AO.</u> No more than 2 apprentice sessions at non-ISI meets.

# **Meet Referee**

- 2. Must be certified DR and AR for 1 year. Must have worked as DR at least 6 sessions, with 2 different MR and as AR for 2 sessions within past 18 months. 2 DR sessions must have been with NT swimmers and 2 at P/F. Serve as assistant MR for min. 4 sessions at 2 meets. 2 sessions must be with NT swimmers, and 2 sessions must be P/F. Maintain certification as DR and work at least 2 sessions every 2 years as MR.
  - a. Recommend MR should maintain certification both as DR and AR.
- 3. Must be certified as DR and AR for 1 year. <u>Must have worked as DR/AR for 8 sessions within past 18 months.</u> 2 sessions must have been with NT swimmers, and 2 at P/F. <u>Certification as N2 DR is preferred</u>. Serve as assistant MR for min. 4 sessions at 2 meets. 2 sessions must be with NT swimmers, and 2 sessions must be P/F.

#### Recertification

Apprentice forms do not mention recertification.

## Stroke and Turn Judge

No discrepancies.

### Chief Judge

Requirements same as ST.

# **Admin Official**

- 1. Must work at least 4 sessions per year, with at least 1 as AO or higher. Other sessions can be personnel supervised by AO, such as CC, timing system, etc. Recommend clinic and/or test.
- 2. Must work at least 4 sessions per year, with at least 2 as AO or higher. Pass online AO test every 2 years.
- 4. Must work at least 4 sessions per year, with at least 2 as AO or higher. Pass online AO test every 2 years.

#### Starter

No discrepancies.

USA Swimming minimum requirements and current Section G do not mention DR, AR or MR, just Referee. Officials Committee requirements document also mentions Referee for recertification.

#### Referee

- 1. Must work at least 6 sessions per year as SR or higher with at least 1 session as Referee. Must attend clinic or retake tests (assumed to mean ST, TJ, CC, AR and Referee) every 3 years.
- 2. Referees must complete the online Referee and Admin Referee recertification test every 2 years.
- 4. Work at least 6 sessions per year with at least 1 as Referee. Pass online DR and AR tests every 2 years.

# **Deck Referee**

2. Work a minimum or **4 sessions per year** as DR, AR or MR. *It is implied to pass the online Referee test every 2 years.* 

## Admin Referee

2. Work a minimum of **4 sessions per year** as DR, AR or MR. It is implied to pass the online Admin Referee test every 2 years.

# Meet Referee

2. Work at least 2 sessions every 2 years as MR. Recertification assumed to be per Referee.

### **Expired Certifications**

Requirements for certifications expired for different time periods are listed on the Officials Committee requirements document. These will need to be re-written, as recertification clinics are no longer held.
