### **IASI Officials Committee Restructure Task Force**

**Background:** On May 15, 2025, a request was made to the IASI Officials Committee to have a sub-committee formed to evaluate the positions of the Committee and their roles and responsibilities.

**Purpose:** The Task Force will make recommendations to the Committee on:

- The appropriate number of members for the Committee; and
- The duties and responsibilities of the Committee and the members of the Committee.

In evaluating the current structure and duties and responsibilities of the Committee, the Task Force will:

- a. Review and understand the IASI Bylaws provisions that apply to the Committee
- b. Review and understand Section G of the IASI Policies and Procedures
- c. Review and understand the current USA Swimming, Inc. policies and procedures for certifying LSC officials.
- d. Conduct a survey of the current Committee members on:
  1. Their understanding of their individual duties and responsibilities as members of the Committee and how they are fulfilling their duties and responsibilities; and
  2. Their thoughts and recommendations on the need to restructure the Committee to better serve IASI athletes.
- e. Conduct a survey of the current IASI certified officials on:
  1. Their understanding of the duties and responsibilities of the Committee and how the Committee is fulfilling its tasks in achieving the duties and responsibilities of the Committee; and
  2. Their thoughts and recommendations on the need to restructure the Committee to better serve IASI athletes.
- f. Meet, review, analyze, and discuss the current structure of the Committee considering the information gathered under items a. through e., above, and make a written recommendation to the Committee of the appropriate size for the Committee and duties and responsibilities of the Committee and the members of the Committee.

**Proposed Timeline:** The Task Force will begin upon approval of the purpose of the Task Force and provide its written recommendation to the IASI Officials Committee by August 31, 2026.
