Open Water Meets

Iowa is adding Open Water competitions to our sanctioned events. The LSC has been working on plans, venues, events, and requirements for conducting Open Water competitions in Iowa. Many of the Iowa LSC athletes have already competed in Open Water events. Once the LSC work is complete, Iowa athletes will have the opportunity to compete at the LSC, Zone, and National levels.

Open Water Swimming is typically defined as any competition that takes place in rivers, lakes, oceans, or other non-pool bodies of water. However, some Open Water events are held in the pool environment. Open Water competitions are distance events, with the most common races ranging from 1 to 10 kilometers. Open Water competition is to swimming what the marathon is to track and field: an endurance event where athletes

compete outside, dealing with environmental and other challenges during the race. The Open Water 10K Swim is an officially recognized Olympic event, which was contested for the first time at the 2008 Summer Olympic Games in Beijing, China.

As an LSC official, Open Water presents some new certifications to obtain, along with unique challenges and skills to learn. Safety is paramount in Open Water events and officiating at an Open Water competition is very different than at a pool competition. Rules for Open Water Swimming are found in Part Seven of the USA Swimming Rule book.

Over the next few months, the LSC will be providing guidance, requirements, and training to officials who would like to become certified Open Water officials.

Championship Meet Season

Championship Meet season will be here before you know it! The Silver Championships are first, on February 8-10 at both Linn-Mar (East) and West Des Moines (West). The Age Group SC Championships follow on February 14-17, and finally the Senior SC Championships are on February 21-24, these last two both at the Wellmark YMCA in Des Moines. All these meets will need a considerable number of officials to run smoothly. Please consider signing up for a few sessions at one or more of them, even if you don't have a swimmer attending. The Age Group and Senior

Championships will be Officials Qualifying Meets (OQM), with national evaluators available to give N2 and N3 evaluations. Signup links will be posted on the ISI Officials website.

Qualifying swimmers from lowa will also be heading to Speedo Sectionals, held this year on March 14-17 in Rochester, MN. This is a great opportunity to gain officiating experience at a higher level meet. The officials' signup for this meet is now available on the Central Zone website.

Reminders!

Your officiating credentials must be up to date before you can work a meet in 2019. This includes:

- <u>For everyone</u> renewal of USA Swimming nonathlete membership
- For about half of us renewal of LSC certification
- <u>As needed</u> renewal of APT and background check

Attendance at all Officials sessions of the 2018 Swimposium can be used in lieu of the online test for 2018 recertification.

Backstroke Ledges

At pools with backstroke ledges (currently both U of Iowa CRWC and Wellmark YMCA), start end turn

judges may be asked to follow a different protocol than normal before the start of each heat. Instead of "wrapping for toes", you step forward to the edge of the pool to assist the starter in observing that the swimmers' feet are correctly placed before the race starts. Swimmers using the ledges must have at least 1 toe from each foot in contact with the wall.
