## **Adoption of Minutes**

# Report from the Officials Chair (Julie Slater for Curtis Witt)

#### ISI Officials numbers

- Numbers currently stand at 223, down 13% since October meeting
- 29 people have attended clinics and passed online test since Jan 1

## **Upcoming USA Swimming rule changes**

- 15m mark to be marked on deck or wall of pool
  - Marks to be used to line up lane line buoys at start of meet
  - Judging will now be done <u>off these marks</u> instead of the lane line buoys.
  - Effective date: May 1, 2019

## **House of Delegates Proposals**

## **Carryover Proposals**

- Championship Meet Host Requirements
  - LSC will be responsible to host LSC Championship meets
  - Not sure if this includes Silvers (later confirmed at HoD meeting it does not)
  - o Discussion
    - Concern about ability of LSC to find volunteers to cover pre-meet work outside of a host team arrangement.
  - Officials are opposed.
- All-Star / Zone Championship meets
  - Team travel will be required for 11&O athletes.
  - Discussion
    - Concern about mandating. What about kids with food allergies, etc.?
    - If pick up is limited to Cedar Rapids and Des Moines, this will still require significant driving for some parents.
  - Consensus from officials to support team travel but to oppose a mandate.

#### **New Proposals**

- Proposal A: Do not include 800m Free Relay in Long Course Champs
  - Consensus that officials are opposed.

- Proposal B: Short Course Champs Bonus Cuts
  - Discussion
    - Difficult for meet admin to cope with for the proposal as written.
    - Want a proposal similar to other meets like Sectionals or Pro Series
  - Consensus that officials are opposed to proposal as written, but support bonus cuts.
- Proposal C: Open Water Sanctioning (Mike Repko to present to HoD for Officials Committee)
  - Details from Mike Repko
    - Sanctioning process is written to meet USA Swimming rules.
    - Process mirrors standard meets regarding sanctioning, but with additional safety protocols.
  - Officials support proposal.
  - Discussion
    - To kick start adding OW events to calendar, are there any existing non-sanctioned events we can bring into USA Swimming / ISI?
- Proposal D: Update to ISI P&P Section G (Robert Fry to present to HoD for Officials Committee)
  - Block proposal.
    - HoD procedural details were described.
  - Officials support proposal.
- Proposal E: ISI Bylaws Update Required by USA Swimming
  - Deadline of Jan 1, 2020 to implement.
  - Has not yet been reviewed
  - No report from the committee
  - Concern about detailed wording
  - Officials are opposed to the update as currently written
- Proposal F: LSC Championship Meets
  - Related proposal to LSC hosting of Championship meets
  - Officials are opposed to proposal as written.
- LSC Budget and Board Nominations
  - These were not present on the ISi website prior to the HoD meeting.
  - Officials do not support material that is not posted to website.

#### **New Business**

# Evaluator(s) for LC Champs (Officials Committee)

- Curt Oppel will be the evaluator
  - Curt requested the Officials Committee to promote to the officials community the value of evaluations to improve the general quality of officiating in the LSC.

## New Officials Clinics for new season (Officials Committee)

- ST clinics have already been held during April.
- Phil Barnes will be hosting an online AO clinic on Wednesday evening, May 1.

#### **Any Other Business**

A desire was expressed for the Officials Committee to start organizing more regular general officials meetings / conferences, for education. This would include all lowa swim officials, including YMCA, HS, rec. league, etc. The rationale is that another Swimposium may not be held for a number of years, and a gathering of this kind is needed more often than this, based on the typical rate of turnover of officials (mostly new group every 4 years or so)

- Suggestion to make the next one coincide with Futures in Des Moines in early August.
  - o Given the session schedule of this type of meet, it would be challenging to accomplish.
  - Similarly, at LSC Champs type meets, many officials also have children attending the meet, and must spend time outside of sessions attending to their needs.

• Suggestion that the best time to hold this type of event is at the beginning of a swim season.

Question to Officials Committee regarding travel expense reimbursement for officials traveling to high level meets outside the LSC.

- Money was allocated a few years ago but not spent. This has now lapsed
- In order to distribute any funds, the Officials Committee must first develop a process, regarding eligibility, how to apply, etc. This has not been done to date.
- It was noted that a proposal was also previously made for a funded LSC officials swap. A group of Iowa officials would attend a meet at another LSC, and a group of their officials would attend an Iowa meet, with each group reporting back lessons learned to their respective LSCs. This has not been followed up to date.
