WHY POOLS & GLASS

Not only is broken glass on a pool deck a safety concern for the barefoot users walking around, glass is nearly invisible when it's in the pool, and can present a very real danger to swimmers.

SAFETY CONCERNS FOR BROKEN GLASS



- Broken glass can puncture bare skin on the pool deck or in the water
- Broken glass can be inadvertently ingested while swimming or get in a swimmer's eye
- Broken glass can cause damage to filtration systems

THE COST OF GLASS BREAKING IN/NEAR THE POOL

Since glass is virtually invisible once it enters the water, the only way to ensure all broken glass is thoroughly removed is to DRAIN and CLEAN the pool. That means draining HUNDREDS of **THOUSANDS** of gallons of water at the cost of **TENS** of **THOUSANDS** of dollars; a very slow process that means closing down the pool and canceling programs for a minimum of **TWO WEEKS**.
