*Understand that criticizing, name-calling, use of abusive language or gestures directed toward coaches, officials, volunteers, and/or any participating swimmers will not be tolerated.

*Respect the integrity of the officials.

*Recruiting swimmers from another team is a violation of Boise Swim Club policy. We are confident that our program will attract the swimmers and families that will embrace our values and philosophies of Boise Swim Club.
