Coeur d'Alene Area Swim Team (CAST) 2023 – 2024 Membership Cost Structure

Fees:

USA Swimming Registration fee: CAST is part of USA Swimming, which requires all CAST members to register and pay registration fee directly to USA Swimming via link sent by the team.

Dues:

CAST families must prepay training dues monthly. Dues must be paid on the first of each month via electronic draft from bank account or via automatic credit or debit card payment.

Training Dues: CAST is a year-round program, with rates varying according to each training group. Coaches assign groups and upon move-ups, the new rate will apply for the remainder of the year.

Monthly KROC Center Dues: CAST uses the Kroc Center for training. All Crocs must be a member in good standing of the Kroc Center to swim with CAST. Discounts are available through the Kroc Center for CAST members. See the Kroc front desk for more details.

Other Charges:

Swim Meets: Each meet in the Inland Empire has a surcharge whether a CAST coach attends or not. In addition, each event has its associated fee. These charges are billed in the month following a given meet.

Penalties:

<u>Discontinued membership:</u> By joining CAST, a swimmer commits to participating from September 1 through August 31. This penalty is assessed when a swimmer discontinues membership within that time frame. ** Withdrawal from the team for any reason **requires a 30- day written notice.** A cancellation form can be found on the CAST website. All outstanding fundraising and service hours commitments will be due at time of cancellation, along with the discontinuation fee.

** Discontinued Membership penalty will go into effect January 1, 2024

Monthly Late Charge: This fee is assessed whenever a bill is not paid by the 10th of each month.

Credit Card/Debit Card Surcharge: Automatic credit or debit card payments will include a 3% transaction fee.

Service Hours Shortages:

- General: All CAST members, including families new to the team, are obligated to volunteer 10 hours of service to the team. Any shortage of hours is billed on July 1 or upon discontinuation of membership at the rate stated above. Service hours are only prorated based on joining date.
- Kroc Meets: All CAST members, including first year families, are required to volunteer for a minimum of 2 of the Service Hours obligation by filling an on-deck job at every meet hosted at the Kroc Center. This includes, but is not limited to: timing, runner, clerk of course, awards preparation and welcome desk. Any shortage of these hours is billed in the month following the event at a doubled rate.

Discounts:

Multiple Swimmer Discount: For members who have multiple swimmers, discounts are available. Discounts do not apply to C squad swimmers.
