All Bids are due by midnight, April 30, 2022 - To allow scheduling for Spring HOD Approval

Late invitational bids will be considered in the order received after all other meets are scheduled.

Teams hosting traditional meets will have first priority.

Consider the following when placing bids:

IES 14/under Jr. Champ - February 17-19 (To bid at Spring HOD)

IES Jr. Olympics - March 3-5 - (Moscow - Vandal Aquatics)

IES Long Course Jr. Olympics - July 22-24 (Pasco - TCCC)

Instructions for filling out the Bid Forms:

- 1. Secure the facility. Make sure you have something in writing about the date and hours.
- 2. Secure a Meet Referee. It is the host team's responsibility to find a meet ref. Please make sure you have written verification of their intent to serve.
- 3. List the dates that the meet is to be held. If it is a two-day (or more), please list all days of the meet.
- 4. Check off the type of meet that it is.
- 5. List the sponsoring club(s). Make sure to list the clubs full name.
- 6. If the meet has a specific name (Mayflowers), please list it.
- 7. List the meet director, meet referee, and other contact. Make sure to include an email address.
- 8. Check that all items have been secured
- 9. Initial that you understand the meet implementation procedures
- 10. Sign the bottom of the form that states you understand the requirements to host a meet.
- 11. Make sure your application is submitted in time. Note please complete one form for each meet bid.
- 12. A Host Club must have started the Safe Sport Club Recognition (SSCR) program to be eligible to bid.
