- SCRATCH PROCEDURES: The IES scratch procedures and no-show rules will be used at this meet. These rules are described in the current IES Policies & Procedures Section 5.7.12
 - Preliminary heats of individual events and all timed final events are pre-seeded. Scratching
 from these heats and events is not required. Athletes/teams not reporting for or competing
 in these heats and events will not be penalized.
 - Athletes will have 30 minutes after the announcement of finals event qualifiers to declare
 their intention to scratch from finals events and must declare their final intention to scratch
 or swim within 30 minutes of their last individual preliminary event of that session. Head
 coaches or their designee will report to the Admin Office to declare their athlete's intention
 to scratch finals events.
 - Any qualifying swimmer who does not declare an intention to scratch a finals event and fails to compete in that finals event will be barred from competition for the remainder of the meet.
