If the 2008 Trick or Treat Meet in Moscow, Idaho
was any indication of the season to come, Channel Cats are going to have a great season!! Seventeen swimmers competed as a Channel Cat for the first time, or in their first short course meet as a Channel Cat. The team brought home $3^{\text {rd }}$ place with Claire Schaef earning the 8 \& under girls high point award. Ten swimmers had all best times and the team earned 420 best times total. Wow! That's some kind of swimming!

There were quite a few amazing swims like Sarah Olsen busting almost a minute and a half off her mile time! Our 9-10 girls 200 Medley Relay broke the meet record (Kelsey Olsen, Alexis and Blair Murphy and Alyssa Musick), Stephen Antoniak beat his best 500 free time by nearly 32 seconds and Claire Schaef (8 years old) swam the 500 free for the first time ever and did it in 7 and a half minutes. More notable time drops were: Natalie Burke-18 sec . in the 200free, Courtney Comrie- 14 sec . in the 100 IM , Alex Fievez nearly 20 sec . in the 100IM, Taylor Fievez almost 25 sec . in the 500 free, Chyna
Fish in 3 events took $16 \mathrm{sec}, 12$ sec . and 12 sec . off in her 200IM, 200free and 1001M. Ally Fuller dropped 17 sec . in her 500free and about 10 in her 200 free while Jillian, Jordan and Joseph Hendry all busted time in 3 events: Jillian 16 sec in the 200 free, 19 sec . in the 50 fly! And 10 in the 100 free. Jordan took off 28 sec . in his 200free! He also had a 14 sec . drop in his 100 back and 11 in his 100 free. Joseph was 11 in
his 200 free, 17 in the 200 breaststroke and 11 in the 200IM. Luis Hernandez-Mejia dropped 12 sec in his 200IM, Alex Killian dropped 12.5 in her 200free while Danica Marlin took off 12.5 in her 100 fly and 14.5 in her 200IM and sister Dominique dropped 13 second in her 200free, 12 in her 1001 M and 13 in her 100 back. Elizabeth McCarthy bested her times by 12 sec . in the 200free and 2001M and 10 in the 200 back. Hailey Murphy broke 20 minutes in her first ever mile swim, Ashton Pollick took off 13 sec and 10.5 sec in his 500 free and his 100 breaststroke. And finally, Mackenzie Ruby had tremendous underwater kicks off ALL her walls, well past the flags! She even earned a few victories in tight races over her competitors quite obviously by having the determination to work the kick off the walls even at the end of her races. Congrats to these Cats who had some great swims!

In addition to the best times we have milestone swims. Swimmers that break :30 for the 50 free, 1:00 for the 100, 2:00 for the 200 and 5 minutes for the 500 free (and so on) earn a big candy bar at our annual Awards Banquet in May. Already we had a bunch of milestones! Nick Connors and Miles Phillips earned it in the 200yd free, Max Timm-Ballard, Nolan McCants and Joseph Hendry in the 100yd free, and Taylor Fievez, Katelyn McLoughlin, Micah Cruz and Nolan McCants in the 50yd free as well. Nolan gets two! That doesn't happen often. Nice swims everyone.

The ten swimmers with all best times were Alex and Taylor Fievez; Chyna Fish; Jillian, Jordan and Joseph Hendry; Alex and Tristan Killian; Sean Stephens and Max Timm-Ballard. Chyna not only had all best times but if you noticed above, she dropped lots of time in 3 events as well. Well done Cats!

## Channel Cats Host Meets in January

TCCC is hosting the IES 10 and Under Championship meet, and the IMX Challenge meet on the $24^{\text {th }}$ and $25^{\text {th }}$ of January, 2009. This meet is at the Central Washington University Aquatic Facility in Ellensburg. Parents are needed to perform all of the tasks necessary to host these events. The formats have been adjusted so that no events will occur on Friday, which will hopefully result in some savings to our IES parents. However, we will need to enter the aquatic facility in Ellensburg at 7 am on Saturday morning to set up and be ready for warm-ups at 10am, with a meet start time of 11 am . The 10 and under Championship will probably last until 3 pm , and then, after a warm-up, the first two events of the IMX Challenge will be conducted. The balance of the IMX events will be run on Sunday, and it is hoped that we will complete the meet mid-afternoon. Exact timelines depend on the number of entries.

Joan Wertz is serving as the meet director and will be working with the coordinators to enlist the help of all our parents. For the Championship meet we do get assistance from the participating teams in timing, but for the IMX Challenge, which is an invitational meet, we are responsible for all timing. Thanks in advance for your support of this important team event.
