The summer of 2015 began with a lot of hope and optimism for our team. I think we were all anxious about whether we could repeat as Long course Champions, and three-peat with Long Course-Short Course-Long Course championships. Turns out there wasn't much to be anxious about. Our team was the star of the show at the IES Champs in every way. With all due respect to CAST, our team was more spirited over the weekend, outswam everyone in the pool, and our parent volunteers again proved that we have no peer when it comes to timing, officiating, and helping a meet run smoothly.

In the end, our team was well over 700 points better than our nearest competitor, the Spokane Waves—and it was a complete team effort! I was so impressed by all of our new families who made the commitment to come to Spokane—and even more impressed by the efforts of those new swimmers. Several of them scored many points for our team. We had three age group high point winners in the meet: Aiden Grigsby (8&U Boys), Sierra Hartley (11&12 Girls), and Connor Elwyn (13&14 Boys) and several others that were close. We had one IES Record (13&14 Boys 400 Free Relay) out of Connor Elwyn, Tage Madson, Cameron Wheeler, and Braden Dilly. And we had one new Age Group Zone Qualifier sending our total to 11 swimmers in Maui as Simon Madson joined brother Tage, Braden Dilly, Connor Elwyn, Hannah VanHeyningen, Rae Ann Dressel, Sierra Hartley, Haily Payne, Andreas Broxson, Jack Wierzbicki, and Trenten Calloway for the exciting trip. I cannot stress enough what a team effort it was. We had many individual IES Championships team records fell in the process, with many relay teams doing the same. Many of our athletes (in fact nearly all) scored at least one point for the team.

We continued the fun in Fresno, California sending our largest contingent ever to the Senior Zone Meet in Fresno. Rebecca Bay, Jordan Hartley, Jessica Wierzbicki, Hank Bergstrom, Kaleb Pringle, and Jared Vargas represented Velocity on the IES All Stars. Our team members contributed greatly to the IES winning the All Star Championship at the meet. Jordan Hartley, Jessica Wierzbicki, and Jared Vargas all earned finals swims for Velocity and each athlete has best times at the meet. Several team records were broken at this meet as well. That same weekend Isabelle Dressel competed and earned best times and team records at the Future Championship in Gresham, OR.

At Age Group Zones, we had several swimmers reach the top 16 and our athletes contributed to some really good relay performances as well. Additionally, several team records were broken, new higher level meet time standards were achieved. Earning individual top 16's were: Sierra Hartley, Haily Payne, Hannah VanHeyningen, Braden Dilly, and Connor Elwyn. Congrats to our entire team! What a summer, Velocity HAA!!!
