MONTHLY DUES

WWSC offers 2 payment options:

- 1) Monthly payments (11) Members will be charged dues on the first day of every month (except for August). There is generally a two week grace period before a late fee is assessed on the 15th of the month if payment is not received.
- 2) In-Full (available in Aug/Sep only) Members who register at the beginning of the swim season have the option to pay their dues for the entire year all at once and receive a small discount.
