If I have a swimmer currently registered with USA Swimming and the COHO Swim Club, then they and their parents agree to follow this policy.

If a parent(s) violates the Code of Conduct, the coaching staff will notify them. The Executive Board of the Parents' Association will review each case. Depending on the severity of the infraction, the committee may recommend suspension from practices and meets for either the parent(s), the swimmer, or both (without a refund for the length of suspension), counseling (with written proof that counseling was obtained), or termination from participation on COHO for themselves or family members.

In all cases, the Head Coach or a coaching staff member, Safe Sport Coordinator, representative of the COHO Parents Association, or Deerfield Park District will communicate with the parent(s) regarding the infraction and penalty. A meeting with the Executive Board may also be arranged. Such a meeting provides the opportunity for the parent(s) to present their case. The decision of the Executive Board is final with no recourse.
