Become a Safe Sport Recognized Club and demonstrate your team's commitment to safeguarding your athletes and all

The Safe Sport Recognized Club program allows clubs to demonstrate their commitment to creating a safe, healthy, and positive environment for all of their members through the development and implementation of Athlete Protection Policies, Safe Sport Best Practices, and Safe Sport deucation.

Safe Sport Recognized Clubs earn a badge to display on their website, and these clubs will be designated as Safe Sport Recognized in USA Swimming's Find-a-Club online tool.

WHAT'S INVOLVED IN THE SAFE SPORT RECOGNITION PROGRAM?




