

2012 AGE GROUP CHAMPIONSHIPS HOSTED BY PALATINE TIGER SHARKS FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

*Do I have to work if my child is not swimming?

Yes, we need each and every family to work this meet. We are asking that if you do not have a swimmer participating, that you only work 2 sessions.

*Can I work 2 sessions in a row?

Yes, a family can work 2 sessions at a time to fulfill the obligation. You can work the morning session and then mid-day session or mid-day session and then evening session. A family can also work in the same session in 2 different jobs.

*Can a high school student get service hours for this event?

Yes, if they are 9th grade or older and have transportation to and from the meet.

*Will my high school student get service hours for the event?

Yes, a service letter will be given to the student after the meet if requested.

*I have younger children, my child is not swimming, why should I work at this meet?

The funds generated from this meet help keep all of our swim team fees down. We understand how difficult it can be to find child care for younger children, and that it is hard to give up a day during the weekend. This is why we are limiting the required sessions. We ask that everyone try to find the time to help out.

*Why are jobs not listed under the age group sign up?

The Age Group Champs committee will look at each session, each person signed up, and jobs that people have worked before. The list of jobs will then be posted in February.
