



## SPORTSMANSHIP CONDUCT POLICY

- 1. We understand that swimmers are to stay on deck or in team area during a meet. It is not a coach's job to leave the deck or team area to find a swimmer.
- 2. Swimmers will be ready to report to the bullpen 5 or 6 events prior to their event.
- 3. We understand that running and horseplay are not allowed at swim meets.
- 4. We will not bring inappropriate items to the meets. Items such as card games, video games, music, coloring, etc., are all great options of things to bring to meets while waiting around.
- 5. We will only bring and eat food in the designated areas at our YMCA as well as any facility that we visit. We will completely clean up the area that our team has used before we leave. We understand that this affects our team and may determine whether we are invited back to a meet or whether our YMCA will allow us to use the facility again.
- 6. We will show good sportsmanship to teammates, other swimmers, coaches, parents, and administration. We will wish our competitors well while we are in the bullpen and after a swim.
- 7. We, parents, understand that we can count on each other to protect our children and our team reputation. We will keep an eye on our team and team area and help monitor when we feel it's necessary.
- 8. We understand the team sportsmanship and conduct rules, and we understand that violation of any of the above rules may result in a disqualification from the meet or future meet, as well as any other disciplinary action that the Head Coach may feel is appropriate.
