- Questions regarding the details of the Discover Card sponsorship?
- Is Illinois swimming asking for an "opt-out" clause in the agreement? Illinois Swimming will honor the USA Swimming "opt-out" list as it pertains to membership mailing lists. Does Illinois Swimming have any control or veto power over what is mailed to the membership? Bob Welch

noted that the current Illinois Swimming policy does not include a privacy statement. Distribution of credit materials and advertisements, etc to minors is a consideration.

Hello All,

Attached are the December financial statements. I apologize but I won't be able to attend or call in to our 2/10 BOD meeting. Therefore, my remarks on the current financial position of ISI follow:

ISI continues to be in sound financial condition.

Looking at our Balance Sheet: Our assets as of 12/31/09 total \$895,000, which is up from 11/30 by almost \$59,000 and up about \$105,000 from a year ago. Net cash (cash less account payable) at 12/31/09 amounted to almost \$429,000 vs \$374,000 at 11/30 and \$379,000 last year. The Athlete Endowment Fund (AEF) continues to improve from 12/31/08's \$308,000 to \$453,000 this year (recall, we contributed \$60,000 in 10/09), and this is up about \$6,000 from last month.

Now turning to the Month of December P&L: Our athlete registrations continue to run about 2% behind fiscal 2009. At the Gross Profit line, ISI showed a profit of \$73,600 vs a budgeted \$72,600, as meet revenues and sponsorships were slightly favorable, offset by net registration revenue. Our Operating Profit totaled \$54,600 which was \$900 favorable to the budget, as all admin expenses were all favorable except salaries & benefits. The AEF appreciated \$6,000, yielding a net income for the month of \$60,400.

Next, the December YTD P&L: Four months into the fiscal year, our Gross Profit totaled \$289,000, up \$10,200 from the budget. The major contributors are: athlete registrations, meet revenues and the awards banquet, each favorable in the \$3,000 range. At the Operating Profit line, we aggregated \$188,800 vs the budgeted \$176,900, up \$11,900, as our total admin expenses were favorable \$1,700 to the budget. (A note on Other: this is primarily bank charges and interest income, and this account should be favorable close to \$3,000 this year as I had Harris Bank set up a daily sweep arrangement which lowered our banks fees and increased our ability to generate add'l interest income. I didn't budget for this.). The AEF improved over \$28,000 YTD through December, and our net income amounted to \$217,000.

If there are any questions, you can ask me at the March meeting. If not, perhaps Jane could move to approve the December financial statements.

## 10. LSC Sponsored Awards

- ConocoPhillips Outstanding Service Award\*

\*The ConocoPhillips award is presented on behalf of USA Swimming to recipient nominated by Illinois Swimming.

## **10.3** Athlete of the Month

The Athlete of the Month is a sponsored award and was created to recognize the efforts of an outstanding male and female from one of the clubs within Illinois Swimming. This award is meant to recognize not only swimming accomplishment but also academic and community or charitable service.

## AGE GROUP VICE-CHAIR REPORT BOD – February 10<sup>th</sup>, 2010

2010 LC Regional Championships (SCY): We received 5 bids to host the first series of LC Regional Championships in SCY pools. Bids were submitted by: DesPlaines River Racers at Maine West HS, Homewood-Flossmoor Swim Club at Homewood-Flossmoor HS, Lake Forest Swim Club at UIC, Lincoln-Way Swim Association at Lincoln-Way West HS, and Scout Aquatics at Lake Forest HS. <u>The age group committee recommends that Lake Forest Swim Club, Lincoln-Way</u> <u>Swim Association, and Scout Aquatics be the host clubs for the 2010 LC Regional Championships.</u> These meets will be held July 23-25, 2010 and will follow the exact same meet format as the short course regional meets. The team assignments for these meets are attached to this report. As this is a new meet and with very little to go by, we had to base all our numbers on 2009 SC Regional meet data. We are hopeful we have made 3 balanced meets, but will have a better idea of numbers for these meets after year 1.

<u>2010 Championship Meets:</u> Everything seems on track for all 5 Regional Championships and the Age Group Championship meet. Peter and I will present a recap of the meets at our March (Regional) and April (Age Group) meetings.

Age Group Training Camp / Diversity Camp: We are starting a new camp for age group swimmers this year – the Age Group Training Camp. This camp is targeting the 11-14 year old swimmers who are in the 9-16 range at our AG State meet or just outside that bubble. We are hoping to have 48 swimmers placed in this 1 day camp. The camp is tentatively scheduled to be held at Stevenson HS on May 15<sup>th</sup>. Athletes selected for this camp will be notified in mid-April. This camp will consist of 2 water sessions and 2 classroom sessions. We will have two national level Illinois athletes attend the camp for part of the day and work with the kids. They will also be involved in 1 of the classroom sessions and lunch. The cost of the camp will be \$30 per swimmer. This cost will cover lunch, a shirt for each swimmer, and a camp swim cap. Another area we wanted to get more heavily involved in was diversity within our sport. Our initial goal was to run a diversity camp in the summer 2010, but we don't feel comfortable that we have enough knowledge on how to run a successful camp at the LSC level. The committee has decided instead to send 2 athletes, 1 coach, and 1 LSC diversity coordinator to the USA Swimming Central Zone Diversity Leadership camp/seminar. The camp will take place June 10-13 at IUPUI. More details will be available at our next BOD meeting.

**2011 LC Age Group Championship Format:** We are in the beginning stages of formatting the LC 2011 Age Group Championships. As you all know, at the Fall HOD the house voted to make the LC Age Group meet a full 4 day prelim/finals meet for 11-14 yr olds, with 10&U still timed finals but competing over 3 days instead of 2. We will be adding the 200's of stroke for the 11/12 age group and will have format to present to the spring HOD so clubs know what the meet details will be when submitting their bids in August 2010.
