Racing Start Proficiency: Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a YMCA certified coach or USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water.



ELIGIBILITY

ATHLETE

YMCA Membership: An athlete must be a YMCA member in good standing who holds an annual, full privilege membership at the YMCA he/she represents for a period of at least 90 days prior to the first day of the meet. An athlete may have only represented that YMCA team in competition for a period of 90 days prior to the first day of the meet, excluding scholastic competition.

Athlete Protection Training: All swimmers age 18 and older have completed Child/Athlete Protection Training within the past 12 months.

Amateur Status: An athlete may not have represented a college, university or other post-high school institution in any competition and may not have accepted pay or compensation for competing as a swimmer.

Unattached Athletes: There is no unattached status in YMCA Swimming.

Age: Swimmer's age as of March 1, 2025 will determine his or her age for the entire meet. An athlete must not be older than twenty-one (21) years of age on the first day of the Meet. Athletes age 12 and under may not compete in Technical Suits, as defined in the USA Swimming Rulebook.

YMCA Meet Participation: Athletes must have competed in a minimum of 2 closed YMCA competitions as defined by the "SWIMMING ADDENDUM TO THE RULES THAT GOVERN YMCA" in order to participate in the meet.

Times: An athlete must achieve the minimum qualifying time standard for each event in which he/she enters during the period of March 1st of the previous year and the entry deadline. There are no qualifying times for athletes with a disability.

Athletes with a Disability: Swimmers with a disability are welcome to enter this meet. The coach or team entry person must alert the meet director and the meet referee as to the need for any special accommodations or seeding arrangements at the time the entry is submitted. If modifications to USA Swimming rules are necessary, then the coach or athlete must notify the meet referee of any disability prior to competition. See appendix 4 & 5



COACH

<u>Required Certifications:</u> Required Certifications: Coaches must hold current certifications in the following courses in order to receive a deck credential:

- BLS/Professional Rescuer CPR
- First Aid
- Safety Training for Swim Coaches Online and In-water training (a Lifeguard certification may be used if accompanied by completion of the Safety Training for Swim Coaches online content)
- Principles of YMCA Competitive Swimming and Diving
- Athlete Protection Training

A list of the acceptable certifications can be found in the <u>Swimming</u> <u>Addendum to the Rules That Govern Competitive Sport</u>.

All coaches are responsible for the conduct of their swimmers and will see that their club has proper supervision at all times. Meet Marshals have the authority to remove any swimmer and/or spectator from the meet for any violation such as improper behavior, damage to property, etc. No smoking on the premises. Please encourage your parents and swimmers to clean up after themselves. In accordance with the Federal Video Voyeurism Prevention Act of 2004 – the use of camera phones or video recording devices in the locker rooms is prohibited. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including cell phones, is not permitted in the changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms. Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited. Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

<u>Coach Registration</u>: Each coach must have completed the annual YMCA on-line coach registration process. Coaches who are not registered and approved will not be permitted on deck.

<u>Teams without A Coach at the Meet:</u> All athletes and teams must have at least one certified and credentialed YMCA coach designated as being



responsible for their supervision during competition. When a YMCA team will not have a coach present, that YMCA may authorize an eligible coach from another YMCA attending the meet to be responsible for their athletes at the meet. The Meet Director and Meet Referee must be notified of this situation.

TEAM

<u>Team Registration:</u> Each team must have completed the annual YMCA on-line team registration and paid the annual registration fee.

Insurance: Each team that participates in the meet must have a current and correct Certificate of Liability Insurance, in effect through the last day of the meet.

ENTRY INFORMATION

ENTRY LIMITS:

- There are a maximum of 6 individual events. There is no limit to the number of relays an athlete can participate in.
- Swimmers who fail to meet entry limits by the scratch deadline will be scratched from their last event(s) that day/meet
- There is no individual event limit per team. Teams may enter an unlimited number of swimmers in an individual event as long as they have the qualification time.
- Each team is permitted two entries per relay event.

QUALIFICATION PERIOD: 2025 Illini District Swimming Championship Time Standards are included in this packet. Only swimmers having achieved a qualifying time between March 1st, 2024 and February 19th, 2025 at 12:00 PM are eligible for this meet. All qualifying times must have been submitted to the YMCA ILSWYMS database. There are no qualifying times for athletes with a disability.

USA-S IDs: Only USA-S registered athletes should have an ID number in the Meet Entry File. Teams with USA Registered Athletes must submit a USA Swimming Roster for athlete's times to be submitted to USA Swimming.

TIME STANDARDS: Swimmers must have equaled or bettered the minimum time standard: Appendix 2. Per Illinois YMCA Swimming Rule 7.1.2.: Swimmers qualifying swims must be in the ILSWYMS Database and official times must be obtained in accordance of the requirements in USA-Swimming Technical rules. All times are subject to verification against the ILSWYMS Database.



TIMES: No Times (NT) are not allowed. Entry Times will be allowed in SCY or SCM.

ENTRY FEES: \$3.00 per individual event; \$8.00 per relay entry. \$6.00 swimmer surcharge.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries are due to <u>alex@spyswimmers.com</u> by Monday, February 24, 2025 at 12:00 PM. Entries are to be submitted by email in a Hy-Tek CL2 file. A late fee of \$25 per team or \$2 per swimmer (whichever is less) will be assessed for all late entries. Payment for Championship and Time Trial fees is due prior to the first swimmer splashing.  - c. Registered USA teams within the State are required to provide a copy of their latest USA membership roster from their team portal to the host team. Failure to do so will result in USA ID numbers to be removed fromany swimmer who is not listed on a current USA roster. For unattached swimmers a copy of their USA Swimming Card will do in place of a roster.

OVER-SUBSCRIPTION: The psych sheet will be posted by 12:00 PM February 25, 2025 on the District Website. Scratches will be due Friday February 28, 2025 by 8:00 PM. Scratches must be e-mailed to the entry chair and must include the following information.

- 1. Swim Club Information Club Name, Club Code, Coach of Record and Contact Info (phone & email)
- 2. Swimmer's Information Full Name (Last, First, MI), Event Number, Event Name, & Entry Time)
- 3. Name, information, and club position of person submitting scratches

The deadline for scratches is 8:00 PM Friday February 28, 2025. E-mail Scratches to Alex Totura at alex@spyswimmers.com. The Entry Chair will send a reply stating the scratch e-mail was received. It will be the responsibility of the sender to ensure that the e-mail is received by the entry chair.

VOLUNTEERS/OFFICIALS/TIMERS

OFFICIALS AND TIMERS: A large number of officials are needed to properly handle a meet like this with multiple pools and sessions. There is a need for both YMCA Level I and YMCA Level II and Administrative Officials during Preliminaries, Finals and Timed Finals each day. All officials are strongly encouraged to sign up to work at the meet.

In order to bring a high degree of consistency to the officiating, officials are asked to work as many sessions as possible. All officials shall be experienced and credentialed. All officials shall work under the direction of the Meet Referee.

Questions about officiating at the meet should be directed to the Meet Referee, Ana Johnson

SIGN-UP PROCEDURE: Officials wishing to work the meet should contact the Meet Referee.

ATTIRE: The official's uniform in the Illinois YMCA Swimming will be white shirt over navy bottoms with white shoes and white socks, pants are preferred for finals. Bottoms need to be professional; denim or track pants are not allowed.

Any official that works a minimum of three (3) sessions will receive an official 2025 Illini District Swimming Championship Officials Polo.



CHECK-IN PROCEDURE

MEET CHECK-IN PROCEDURE: Teams and Coaches check-in on Deck with one of the Meet Director. Officials check-in at Hospitality with the Meet Referee.

MEETING SCHEDULE: Pre-Meet meetings will be held at the discretion of the District Chairperson.

CHAMPIONSHIP PROCEDURES AND OPERATIONS

CHAMPIONSHIP COMMITTEE: The Illini District Championships shall be under the general supervision on the Illinois Sate YMCA Swim Committee and direct supervision of the Illini District Swim Committee. Any irregularities, protests or unforeseen situations calling for deviation from these rules shall be decided by the District Championship Protest Committee. The District Protest Committee shall consist of the District Committee Officers, the Meet Referee, the Head Coach of the host team, and an athlete representative. The athlete representative will be appointed at the discretion of the District Chair. Absences of any member of the protest committee may be filled at the discretion of the District Chair or their designee. The District Protest Committee will be called at the discretion of the District Chair, their designate or the meet referee.

RULES: The meet will run under YMCA Rules that Govern Competitive Sport, Swimming Addendum to the YMCA Rules that Govern Competitive Sports, Illinois YMCA Swimming Committee Rules & Regulations, and USA-S Technical Rules.

MEET FORMAT:

- 1. 8U and 10U Events will be competed in the morning sessions of the meet.
- 2. 12U, 14U, 21U Events will be competed in the afternoon sessions of the meet.

INDIVIDUAL EVENTS:

- 1. All Events will be conducted as Timed Finals
- 2. A no show (NS) and declared false start (DFS) for an event counts as an official entry and against the entry limit.

RELAY EVENTS:

- 1. Each team is limited to two entries per relay event.
- 2. All Relays will be conducted as timed finals events.



EVENT SEEDING: All events will be seeded Slowest to Fastest. Entries shall be seeded according to USA Swimming rules. Entry times conforming to the course length for this championship meet (SCY) shall be considered "conforming times". All other times meeting the appropriate standard shall be considered "non-conforming times". The order of seeding for this meet is: Short Course Yards (SCY), Short Course Meters (SCM). The Meet Referee/Administrative Official reserve the right to combine heats.

SCRATCH PROCEDURES: An athlete is considered entered into an event unless he/she scratches from that event prior to the scratch deadline. If an athlete does not scratch from an event and does not swim the event, that event still counts toward the athlete's total number of events for the meet.

DECLARED FALSE START: An athlete may also withdraw from a heat or swim-off by electing to take a declared false start. Such declaration must be made known to the Deck Referee before the heat or swim off is announced. A declared false start counts as an event swim for the athlete and will be counted in the maximum number of events allowed for each athlete.

NO SHOW: An athlete who is seeded in an event and fails to compete (i.e., a "no show") at a timed final event will result in no penalty.

WARM-UP SAFETY PROCEDURES: Teams will be assigned lanes for warm-ups during all sessions. Teams will need to share lane space and work cooperatively in reflection of the YMCA values and sportsmanship should they be assigned to share a lane for warm up.

Athletes are expected to use a three-point entry in which they sit on the side of the pool then slide into the pool gently, with one hand on the wall. The exception is during specific warm up periods when sprint lanes are designated for practicing racing starts.

Coaches are responsible for the safety of their athletes and are expected to monitor them at all times during warm up sessions.

READY BENCH: There will be a bullpen for 8 and under athletes only. That Bullpen will take place on the recreation pool deck.

STARTS: 'Fly-over' starts will be used at this meet. All swimmers (except for Backstroke starts) should remain in the water at the completion of their race until the next heat has begun.

SWIM-OFFS: There will be no Swim-offs for final results.



SWIMS (USA-S): This meet has been approved by USA Swimming. Therefore, all individual times will be automatically submitted for entry into SWIMS as long as USA-S ID numbers have been included with your entry.

RESULTS: Any results displayed on the scoreboard are unofficial until final results are published. Results will be posted in the hallway outside of the entrance to the pool.

CONDUCT AND RESTRICTIONS: The Meet Referee reserves the right to dismiss any swimmer, coach and/or spectator from the competition due to inappropriate conduct

- Except where the venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is prohibited. The USA Swimming Rulebook defines Deck Change as: Changing, in whole or in part, into or out of a swimsuit (excluding a drag suit) in an area other than a permanent or temporary locker room, bathroom, changing room or other space designated for changing purposes while at a practice, competition, or other pool-related activity." This includes slipping off the top of a one-piece performance suit to place on an alternate bikini top immediately following a race.
- In accordance with the Federal Video Voyeurism Prevention Act of 2004, the use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- Photographs are not allowed to be taken behind the block during competition.
- Massage tables are not permitted.
- Individuals are responsible for the security of their personal belongings and are encouraged not to bring valuables to the meet venue and not to leave items unattended.
- Swimmers may use locker rooms to change and shower. However, personal items are not to be stored in lockers
- Swimmers are not permitted in the spectator stands
- Shaving is not permitted in any areas of the facility.
- All swimmers must remain in authorized areas during the meet.

Recording Devices and Swimmer Privacy: Use of audio or visual recording devices, including but not limited to cell phones, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms. Cell phones, video and camera devices are not permitted behind the blocks or above swimmers as they enter or depart the pool. Except where venue facilities require otherwise, changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is not appropriate and is



prohibited. Any individual failing to abide by the above may be subject to immediate removal from the venue by Meet Management and could be subject to the USA Swimming Code of Conduct violation as defined in Articles 304, 305 or 306.

Drones: Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.

- Only the first four finishers from any one association in an individual event shall score team points or receive individual awards.
- Only the first finisher from any one association in a relay event shall score team points or receive awards.

AWARDS:

INDIVIDUAL AWARDS: Championship medals will be awarded for 1st through 16th place. 10 and Under awards, including relays, will be given during Sessions 1 and 3 during the meet after every 4th event. Awards for sessions 2 and 4 will be packaged and given at the conclusion of the meet. Any awards not picked up at the conclusion of the meet will not be mailed.

RELAY AWARDS: Awards for relays will be given for 1st through 8th place.

TEAM AWARDS: Awards for the 10 & Under and 8 & Under age groups will be awarded at the conclusion of session 3. All other awards will be awarded at the conclusion of session 4. Trophies shall be given to the top teams scoring the most points in each competitive age group in each of the boys and girls at the District Championship. High point Trophies shall be awarded to the three teams scoring the highest, second highest and third highest total number of points in each of the boys, girls and combined at the District Championship. Any awards not picked up at the conclusion of the meet will not be mailed.



SPECTATORS

ADMISSION FEE: No admissions fees.

HEAT SHEETS/PROGRAMS: Heat sheets will be posted online after the scratch deadline and made available on Meet Mobile for free. Heat Sheets will also be posted around the facility

CONCESSION STAND: Will be available throughout the meet.

LOST AND FOUND: SPY Swim Team and the Springfield YMCA are not responsible for any lost or stolen property.

MAAPP: All applicable adults participating or associated with the respective meet to which this information applies, acknowledges that they are an applicable adult, subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. All athletes 18 years of age and older must have completed Athlete Protection Training prior to the entry deadline.

Liability Waiver: In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, intending to be legally bound, I/we hereby waive, and release any and all rights and claims for damages which may accrue against USA Swimming, Inc., Illinois Swimming, Inc., Springfield YMCA Swim Team, Springfield YMCA, and their representatives, employees, or successors, for any and all injuries suffered by me or any contestant or representative in said meet as a representative of my club. In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

CONDUCT AND RESTRICTIONS:

- No Flash Photography at the start of competition races.
- No personal chairs are allowed in the spectator area
- Parents are responsible for the conduct of their children. Children are not allowed to roam the facility unattended.
- The use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.
- Spectators are not permitted on deck
- YMCA of Springfield is a No Smoking facility. Absolutely no smoking, drugs, or alcohol are permitted in the building.



LIABILITY, SAFETY AND EMERGENCY PROCEDURES

INSURANCE: Each Association participating in this meet must have insurance coverage for representative(s) including leadership and participants who will be in attendance for the period of the meet. Appendix 3 must be signed by each association participating in the meet.

LIABILITY LIMITS: In consideration of the acceptance of this entry, intending to be legally bound, I/we hereby waive, and release any and all rights and claims for damages which may accrue against USA Swimming, Inc., Illinois Swimming, Inc., Springfield YMCA Swim Team, Springfield YMCA, YMCA Swimming, and their representatives, employees, or successors, for any and all injuries suffered by me or any contestant or representative in said meet as a representative of my club. In granting this sanction it is understood and agreed that USA Swimming shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

EMERGENCIES: the facility personnel will handle all emergencies at the meet. These individuals will provide CPR and first aid as needed and will ensure that individuals with serious injuries are transported immediately to the nearest hospital for further treatment. Defibrillators will be on site.

Any coach, athlete or official who recognizes an emergency situation should immediately inform the facility's personnel and then make sure the vicinity of the emergency is clear for the emergency personnel to do their job.

UNACCOMPANIED ATHLETE: Each athlete must have a certified coach responsible for him/her while on the pool deck. The coach of the athlete must authorize in writing a coach from another team to represent their team and be responsible for the swimmer(s).

CONCUSSION AWARENESS: This meet will follow the YMCA of USA Concussion procedure. Anyone who observes or has knowledge of a potential head injury should immediately notify lifeguards and/or hired medical personnel. Once the injury report is completed, the lifeguard and/or hired medical personnel will notify the Event Staff, the athlete's coaching staff, and the Meet Director.

If a head injury occurs, the action plan below will be followed:

- 1. Athlete is removed immediately from participation by the Meet Director
- 2. Athlete must be evaluated by a licensed health care professional experienced in identifying and treating concussions. In addition, the athlete must be in compliance with the laws that are in effect within the jurisdiction where the meet is held.



- 3. The coaching staff will inform the athlete's parents or guardians about the possible concussion and give or send them the fact sheet on concussion.
- 4. The athlete will not be allowed back to warm-up or compete until a health care professional, experienced in evaluating concussions determines that the athlete is symptom-free and is OK to return to participation.

LIGHTNING POLICY: The National Lightning Safety Institute, National Athletic Trainers Association, American College of Emergency Physicians, USA Swimming, and YMCA of the USA all recommend or require closing an indoor pool during an electrical storm. The facility policy will be followed at the meet.

LODGING

There are several hotels in the area for you Lodging needs.

PARKING

Subject to the rules of the facility. Free parking will be available in front of the facility.
