
# Dolphin Encounters

We want the swimmers to ask themselves "what do I need to do to get to this meet?" This goes all the way up to the National circuit. Not everyone is going to be a Zone level swimmer, or a state level swimmer, and that is ok. We as coaches will provide the tools, motivation, and instruction that can help them get to the level they want to be at.

## New swimming policies!

The team will have new policies for selecting events for swimmers, team suit/caps, wearing technical suits, attending practices, and a new swimmer incentive program called IM Tough.

### Processing Meet Entries

Completing meet entries is the responsibility of the WDST Head Coach. WDST uses Team Unify to power the WDST Website. With the Team Unify website, the WDST Head Coach will set up the Meet as an event and tie a registration deadline to it. The registration deadline will be roughly one week prior to the due date of the entries to the host team.

After the event has been created, all team members will receive an e-mail that the event has been created and members can declare their swimmers intent to swim the meet. WDST will allow parents to initially choose their swimmer's events.

Families and swimmers do not always see where a child's strength will be. It's not always about winning. We want our swimmers to be versatile. Same for relay orders. Coaches may put the relays together in different ways, depending on what they are looking for.

Once the registration deadline has passed, the Head Coach will go into the website and either approve the entries chosen or make any necessary event changes to the swimmers participating in the meet. It is WDST Team Policy, that the Head Coach will have the final say on all swimmer's events.

### Tech Suit Policy

Swimmers wishing to wear a technical suit, a tech suit is defined as a suit with a FINA sticker, require the approval of the Head Coach for any meet. Swimmers who wear a technical suit without the permission of the Head Coach will either be scratched from the current session or from next session's day's events.

Swimmers who are attending Championship meets and wish to wear a technical suit should wear a Nike Technical suit. Swimmers who experience difficulties should approach the Head Coach with any concerns about the suit that they are wearing. Swimmers who wear a non approved technical suit and without the approval of the Head Coach will be scratched from the session's events by Declared False Start.

### Practice Schedules & Groups Policy

Swimmers are to come to their level's designated swim practice time and day. Any swimmer who shows up to another level's practice will be asked to come back at the swimmer's next available practice. Coaches will determine when a child should be moved to a different group. All communications for this will come from the Head Coach to that swimmer's family.

## New swimming policies continued

### Team Suit/Cap Policy

Starting the 2013 -2014 Short Course Season, WDST has signed a sponsorship contract with Nike.

As a result of this agreement between WDST and Nike, WDST has picked out team suits that will be worn by the team when attending any swim meet on WDST's schedule.

All existing members, defined as swimmers on the team during the Long Course 2013 team roster, are grandfathered into this policy. Any new swimmer joining the team during the 2013 -2014 Short Course Season will need to purchase a Nike team suit for meets.

During the 2013 - 2014 Short Course Season, all new swimmers must wear Nike Team Suits, all existing swimmers must wear the previous season's team suit, with an exception with a tech suit. A tech suit is defined as any suit with a FINA sticker on it.

Starting Long Course 2014, all swimmers must have a Nike Team Suit. Swimmers who wear a suit other than a Nike Team Suit without the approval of the Head Coach will be scratched from that session's events.

Swimmers are to wear Nike Suits for all Championship meets. Championship meets are defined as any meet at the end of the season that requires a subsequent time standard to compete in. Any swimmer who wears a non Nike Suit without the approval of the Head Coach will be scratched by the Head Coach declaring a False Start for that swimmer for that session's races

Swimmers must wear a team cap for competitions, any other cap must be approved by the Head Coach.
