IMPORTANT: Male and female volunteer chaperones are needed for all practices at IU pools.

IU policy requires that all children are escorted by adults in IU facilities, including in locker rooms. **We** need male and female chaperones at each practice.

Swimmers should come to practice dressed in their suits and ready to swim. Chaperones will be present to escort swimmers to the locker room for bathroom breaks only. Swimmers should also plan to leave practice in their suits. Please ensure your swimmer is dressed appropriately for the weather.

All chaperones will need to be background checked before volunteering. The volunteer signup will be created on Team Unify at the end of each week. We realize this may be an inconvenience but it is necessary during January — February when middle school and high school teams are utilizing the high school pools.

If we do not have adequate chaperones at least 2 hours before the start of practice then practice will be canceled.

SWIMMER DROP OFF/PICK UP AT POOL 194 (IU School of Public Health, 1025 E. 7th Street)

Swimmers should be dropped off only at the IU School of Public Health's **North Loading Dock** for practice. **Please see Map 1** (**red arrow**). If parents drop off or pick up at other locations, this causes traffic jams and introduces danger for kids entering or exiting their cars and walking to or from the loading dock. Additionally, there will be no chaperones at any other locations except at the North Loading Dock.

Chaperones should remain at the loading dock 15 minutes before practice and will stay until 2 to 3 minutes before practice begins. If you come when a chaperone is not present at the loading dock, then you will need to escort your swimmer to the pool yourself. **Swimmers cannot come to or leave the pool without an adult escort.**

Chaperones will walk swimmers from North loading dock entrance, upstairs from ground to main floor, along hallway (past the basketball courts) to South end of building. Please see Map 2. Near the south end of the facility (prior to exiting), chaperones should navigate to the area that leads to the Dick Enberg studio and the south door to Pool 194 (Note: the hallway proceeds near the entrance to the men's locker room but chaperones should not enter the men's locker room).

After practice, chaperones will escort all swimmers back to the loading dock. You may pick up your swimmer at the loading dock. You may also come into the pool area and escort your swimmer if you wish. **Swimmers cannot come to or leave the pool without an adult escort**.

SWIMMER DROP OFF/PICK UP AT COUNCILMAN BILLINGSLEY AQUATIC CENTER (CBAC at the Student Recreational Sports Center or SRSC, 1601 Law Lane)

Swimmers should be dropped off along the curb at the bottom of the stairs on the south side of the SRSC. **Please see Map 3** (red arrow).

Chaperones should remain at the drop off area 15 minutes before practice and will stay until 2 to 3 minutes before practice begins. One chaperone should remain at the bottom of the stairs while another may remain at the top of the stairs as swimmers "shuttle" up to the lobby to meet the coach.

If you come when a chaperone is not present, then you will need to escort your swimmer to the pool yourself. **Swimmers cannot come to or leave the pool without an adult escort.**

Important: the pool doors into CBAC (Councilman Billingsley Aquatic Center) will automatically lock after the coaches and swimmers enter the pool area. If you arrive late then you will need to use Band or text the chaperone to enter CBAC.

After practice, chaperones will escort all swimmers back to the curb on the south side of the SRSC. You may also come into the lobby and escort your swimmer if you wish. **Swimmers cannot come to or leave the pool without an adult escort**.

PARKING

We know that parking on the IU Campus can be challenging. Using volunteer chaperones is the easiest way to get your child to and from practices. If you are interested in carpooling, please use the Band app or our private parent Facebook page to connect with other families.

After 5:00 PM, parking is free in the residential neighborhood around the School of Public Health (1025 E. Seventh Street). There are paid lots at the Indiana Memorial Union, in the lot west of the School of Public Health, and at the adjacent to the SRSC.




