OFFICIALS:	The Indiana Swim Club will need the help of your USA Swimming Officials. If you have officials willing to help at our meet, please provide his/her name & email address to Jody Madeira (jodymadeira@gmail) or complete the Officials RSVP form HERE.			
MEET FORMAT:	The meet will be timed finals format with three sessions on Sunday. ISC reserves the right to limit the number of entries in any event to achieve a 4-hour maximum timeline. The Meet Entry Chair will notify all accepted teams of any limited ever and will refund the fees for those events limited or reduced from the original entry.			
ELIGIBILITY:	Swimmers must be registered with USA Swimming prior to the competition. Age as of Dec. 7, 2025, shall determine the swimmer's age for the entire meet (205.2.2).			
ENTRY LIMITS:	Athletes may sign up for a max of five (5) individual events.			
ENTRY FEES:	All entry fees must be paid on Saturday, Dec. 7, 2025. Please make checks payable to: Indiana Swim Club. Time final events are \$5.00 each, and there is a \$7.00 per swimmer Indiana Swimming surcharge which must accompany entry. No refunds will be made on entry fees.			
ENTRY DEADLINE:	No entries will be accepted before entries open. Any entries arriving before entries open will not be processed until all entries received during the entry period are processed and the entry deadline has passed. Any entries arriving after the entry deadline will be considered only if the meet does not fill. The deadline may be extended if the meet is not full. All entries must be sent via email. Changes, updates, and corrections will be accepted via email until the modification deadline. ISC reserves the right to limit the number of entries in all events to keep the timelines manageable. ISC will try to accommodate all entered teams until the meet is considered at capacity. Capacity is 300 swimmers. Entries open: Monday, November 17, 2025 8:00 a.m. Entries Close: Monday, December 1, 2025 5:00 p.m.			
CLERK OF COURSE:	There will be a Clerk of Course for all 10&U events.			
AWARDS & SCORING:	No awards will be given. This will not be a scored meet.			

WARM-UP:	Lanes for warm-ups will be assigned by December 5th. Participating teams must adhere to the warmup schedule. This information will also be posted at the facility during the meet.			
SCHEDULE:	Our schedule will be somewhat flexible and schedule to change based on entries. We will have session capacity limits, so we reserve the right to change session times and potential age group combinations during sessions.			
CONCESSIONS:	Limited concession stands will be made available to athletes and spectators.			
	A hospitality area will be available for coaches, officials, and volunteers.			
ADMISSION:	Admission is free.			
PSYCH SHEETS:	Psych sheets will be posted to the meet website by Friday at noon before the start of the meet. Heat sheets will be available for free on MeetMobile.			
PARKING:	Free parking will be available in the parking lots at the front of the school and down by the tennis courts. The pool entrance is an outside entrance on the football stadium side of the building.			
FACILITY NOTE:	 Bloomington High School North is a tobacco-free facility. The Bloomington High School Natatorium is graciously hosting this meet. It is important that all people attending this meet, whether it is swimmers, coaches, or spectators, treat this facility with the utmost care. The following rules will be strictly enforced: Keep all trash picked up (swimmers and teams in particular). Do not go, or let children go, in any unauthorized areas. Please keep children supervised at all times. Due to USA Swimming insurance requirements, ONLY swimmers, coaches, officials, and volunteers are allowed on deck. There can be no exceptions! No radios, balls, or anything that will be an inconvenience to swimmers, coaches, officials, or workers will be allowed. The Indiana Swim Club will have volunteers roaming the deck and locker room areas. If any swimmer is caught abusing the building or facility, they will immediately be asked to leave the meet and will be barred from further competition. 			
SAFE SPORT 360:	The Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy prohibits Applicable Adults (as defined) from having one-on-one interactions with minor athletes who are not within an observable and interruptible distance from another adult. Applicable Adults are required to abide by this policy in full during this meet. Pursuant to USA Swimming Rules and Regulations and federal law, it is every members's responsibility to immediately (i.e., within 24 hours) report any incident of child abuse, including physical or sexual abuse, to law enforcement and the U.S. Center for SafeSport. Reporting must occur when an individual has firsthand knowledge of misconduct or where			

specific and credible information has been received from a victim or knowledgeable third party. A report to the U.S. Center for SafeSport may be made via telephone at 720—531-0340 or online at www.uscenterforsafesport.org/report-a-concern. Various state laws may also require reporting to law enforcement or to a designated child protection agency.

All athletes age 18 and older must complete Athlete Protection Training in order to be a USA Swimming registered member in good standing. Any athlete who turns 18 on or after **December 6, 2025**, who has not completed Athlete Protection Training by the first day of competition, will be prohibited from participating in the competition until such time as all membership requirements are completed. Times achieved by an athlete who turns age 18 on or after **December 6, 2025**, who competes in this USA Swimming sanctioned event without completing this membership requirement, will NOT count for qualification or recognition. This includes participation as a member of a relay.
