#### SANCTION

#### FACILITY

The facility contains one 10 lane x 25-yard pools with 11, 25y yard Competitor lanes and 10 Lane x 25 yard course with Competitor lanes for warm-up & warm-down. Colorado System 7 Timing will be used. 10 x 25-yard lanes will be used for competition and 10 x 25-yard lanes will be reserved for continuous warm-up and warm-down. Spectator seating is available on the west side of the pool. THERE IS ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING OR VAPING IN THE BUILDING.

The competition course has not been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4).The depth of the competition pool measures from the south end 8 feet to 8 feet 2 inches across the 50 meters.

#### PARKING

Free parking will be available in the lots adjacent to Carmel High School. Additional parking is available north of the pool at the football stadium (approximately 1/3 mile).

#### RULES

Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (“MAAPP”), will govern this meet.

USA Swimming Rule 202.5.2 - At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down.

Coaches MUST present their current USA Swimming coaches pass to gain deck access. The meet referee reserves the right to ask for coach credential display and/or deny deck access if a coach does not comply or credentials are no longer valid or current.

**Coaches must show a photo ID at the check in table to gain deck access.**

ABSOLUTELY NO PARENTS WILL BE ALLOWED ON THE POOL DECK. This is an insurance requirement of USA Swimming, and will be strictly enforced.

Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

In swimming competitions, the competitor must wear only one swimsuit in one or two pieces except as provided in 205.10.1. All swimsuits shall be made from textile materials. For men, the swimsuit shall not extend above the navel nor below the knees, and for women, shall not cover the neck, extend past the shoulder, nor extend below the knee.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in the changing areas or locker rooms.

Deck changes are prohibited.

USA Swimming article 202.4.9 J shall apply: Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair.

Any photographs, videotape or other audio and/or visual recordings of the event created by a spectator may be used solely for such spectator's personal non-commercial use, and may not be broadcast, published or disseminated, or used for any commercial purposes, without the prior written consent of USA Swimming.

All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and network(s) of USA Swimming under the conditions authored by USA Swimming, and allow event organizers the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during or after the period of participation in USA Swimming competitions to promote such competitions. All participants agree not to use or authorize use of pictures in the uniforms and equipment provided by USA Swimming for the purpose of trade, without the consent of USA Swimming. All participants agree not to use medals or photos, or portraits or films with the medals, which are received for performances in this competition, for the purpose of trade. Furthermore, participants agree to return these uniforms and equipment, bearing USA Swimming logos and marks, if and when requested.

**Safe Sport 360:** The Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy prohibits Applicable Adults (as defined) from having one-on-one interactions with minor athletes which are not within an observable and interruptible distance from another adult. Applicable Adults are required to abide by this policy in full during this meet.

Pursuant to USA Swimming Rules and Regulations and federal law, it is every member's responsibility to immediately (i.e., within 24 hours) report any incident of child abuse, including physical or sexual abuse, to law enforcement and the U.S. Center for SafeSport. Reporting must occur when an individual has firsthand knowledge of misconduct or where specific and credible information has been received from a victim or knowledgeable third party. A report to the U.S. Center for SafeSport may be made via telephone at 720-531-0340 or online at [www.uscenterforsafesport.org/report-a-concern](http://www.uscenterforsafesport.org/report-a-concern). Various state laws may also require reporting to law enforcement or to a designated child protection agency.

All athletes age 18 and older must complete Athlete Protection Training in order to be a USA Swimming registered member in good standing. Any athlete who turns 18 on or after February 12, 2026, who has not completed Athlete Protection Training by the first day of competition, will be prohibited from participating in the competition until such time as all membership requirements are completed. Times achieved by an athlete who turns age 18 on or after February 12, 2026, who competes in this USA Swimming sanctioned event without completing this membership requirement, will NOT count for qualification or recognition. This includes participation as a member of a relay.

**ELIGIBILITY**

Swimmer(s) must be registered with USA Swimming prior to the competition (202.3.4B). Age as of March 14, 2026 shall determine the swimmer's age for the entire meet (205.2.2). There will not be any USA Swimming registration at the meet.

**TIME STANDARDS**

**Swimmers and relays must have an entry time slower than the Indiana Swimming Age Group State Championship standard.**

**MEET FORMAT**

This is a timed finals meet. Carmel Swim Club reserves the right to limit select events during all sessions if it is deemed necessary to complete the session within the requirements of Indiana Swimming rules. Fees will be refunded for any swimmer cut from an event due to timeline management.

**TIMELINE MANAGEMENT**

Carmel Swim Club reserves the right to limit select events during any or all sessions if it is deemed necessary to complete the session(s) within the requirements of Indiana Swimming rules. Any limits to events will be posted to [www.carmelwimclub.org](http://www.carmelwimclub.org) no later than Thursday, March 12, 2026. Fees will be refunded for any swimmer cut from an event due to timeline management. Carmel Swim Club also reserves the right to combine age groups within given session(s) to control the timeline. Please note that fly-over starts may be used during all sessions.

**ENTRY LIMITS**

Each swimmer will be limited to five (5) individual events and one (1) relay event. If an individual is entered in more than five individual events, the entry will be made by order of events, starting with Event #1 until the limit is satisfied. There will be NO refunds for swimmers entered in more events than permitted.

**ENTRY ACCEPTANCE AND DEADLINES**

- The entry deadline will be 9:00 AM, Friday, March 6, 2026.
- The deadline for changes to entry will be 9:00 AM, Tuesday, March 10, 2026

**ENTRY PROCEDURE**

By 9:00 AM Friday, March 6, 2026, submit your entries via email using the Hytek Commlink file (CL2 file) or Team Unify Standard SD3 file:

- Review your entry for correct contact information prior to submission
- Be sure to include all swimmer's full name and USA Swimming ID number
- All times must be submitted in short course yards (SCY)

- Please include your team name and entry chair's contact information in the email
- You will receive an email within 24 hours confirming that your entry file has been received and processed. This does NOT mean you have been accepted into the meet.

After acceptance, an entry report will be emailed to your team. Be sure to check your entry report for errors. The deadline for changes is at 9:00 AM Tuesday, March 10, 2026. Carmel Swim Club has sole discretion in determining which entries to accept.

**ENTRY FEES**

All fees must be paid no later than 1 hour prior to the start of the first session in which a team/athlete is competing. Please make checks payable to CARMEL SWIM CLUB and include the Release and Hold Harmless Agreement with payment.

- Individual timed final events: \$7.00 per event
- Relay events: \$13.00 per event
- \$7.00 per swimmer, Indiana Swimming surcharge must accompany each entry

#### **DECK ENTRIES**

Deck entries for individual events will be accepted until 60 minutes before the next session is scheduled to begin and at the discretion of Carmel Swim Club. Deck entries will only be accepted provided there is a lane available and only as a new addition. No additional heats will be created to accommodate deck entries. No deck entries will be permitted for events that have been limited. Deck entries will be entered as NT (no time). Entry fee for deck entries is \$14.00 per individual timed final event and \$26.00 for timed final relay events.

#### **CLERK OF COURSE**

Clerk of Course will be provided for 8 & under events only.

#### **RELAYS**

Relay cards must list the full name of swimmers competing on the relay (improperly filled out relay cards may result in the relay failing to swim). Include alternates if appropriate. Relay cards shall be turned in at the Computer table no later than 30 minutes before the start of the meet. Relays are assumed to be swimming unless a coach marks SCRATCH on the relay card and turns it into the Clerk of Course.

#### **SEEDING OF EVENTS**

All events will be pre-seeded.

#### **FINAL RESULTS**

Final results will be posted at the CSC website at [www.carmelswimclub.org](http://www.carmelswimclub.org). Meet results posted through the online application Meet Mobile are not considered final. We will provide coaches with final results in the following formats:

- 6 & Under/7 year old/8 year old/9 year old/10 year old/11-12/13-14 year old: Ribbons will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 8<sup>th</sup> places in individual events and relays.
- Awards will not be mailed.
