Job Description

Swim Lesson Instructors provide in-water instruction to children of various ages and skill levels. The primary responsibility of the instructor is to help swimmers develop proper swimming technique and skills. This is a part-time, seasonal position, averaging 6 hours per week. This position reports to the Head Coach and is supervised by the Swim Lessons Site Supervisor.

Expectations

- Model club values and behaviors
- Work collaboratively and respectfully with other club staff, swimmers, parents and board of directors
- Provide a positive and safe environment for all LCA athletes
- Demonstrate cooperative, prompt, and respectful communication

Responsibilities

- Teach water safety, swim techniques and swimming strokes to students with varying swimming abilities
- Run organized and well-executed classes, as defined by Lawrence County Aquatics
- Assess the progress of students and adjust instruction accordingly
- Identify incorrect technique and correct students accordingly
- Monitor students to prevent accidents and injuries
- Comply with all Safe Sport rules and LCA related Safe Sport initiatives

Qualifications

Requirements

- Must be 15 years of age or older
- Swim at least 25 yards and tread water
- Must be able to complete instructor certification (provided by LCA)
- Pass all pre-employment screenings conducted by LCA
