



PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

1. The publishing of a photograph of swimmer under 18 either on a notice board or in a published article or video recording (including video streaming) of swimming competitions ("publication") will only be done with parents' consent per the Photography Consent Form (available on the website; included in the annual signature forms).
2. A parent or guardian has a right of refuse to have children photographed. The exercise of this right of refusal cannot be used as grounds for refusing entry into a swimming competition. Therefore any photo that may go to press or on a notice board, be it through a member of the club or official photographer, will receive parental consent before publishing/displaying the photo. The form allowing parents to indicate refusal of consent is (available on the website; included in the annual signature forms).
3. The photographer for the Lake Central Barracudas follow the below generally accepted standards of decency: gen
 - Action shots will be a celebration of the sporting activity and not a sexualized image in a sporting context.
 - Action shots will not be taken or retained where the photograph reveals a torn or displaced swim suit.
 - Photographs will not be taken from behind swimming blocks at the start of a race or exhibit a child climbing out of the swimming pool.
 - Photographs will not be taken in locker-rooms or bathrooms.
4. In the case of open meets and other competitions where the host club has notified the Lake Central Barracudas that the host club has an official photographer present, all parents attending the meet will be made aware of this information. If photos are to be published anywhere, the individual parent will be specifically given the opportunity to withhold their consent.
