Athlete Code of Conduct

The purpose of Noblesville Swim Club's Athlete Code of Conduct is to promote behavior in our athletes that supports our mission of <u>building champions through our community values</u>. Any athlete that violates the Athlete Code of Conduct will be subject to disciplinary action. As a condition of membership with Noblesville Swim Club, all athletes agree to the following statements:

- I will not use tobacco products, alcohol, or illegal narcotics. This includes, but is not limited to, vaping.
- I will treat all meet volunteers, including officials, with respect.
- I will not use any audio or video recording devices in locker rooms, changing areas, or restrooms.
- I will not participate in any social media interaction or electronic communication that reflects negatively on my club.
- I will always exhibit good sportsmanship.
- I will not participate in hazing or bullying, and if I have knowledge that hazing or bullying has occurred, I will immediately report it to my coach.
- I will treat each facility where I practice or compete with respect. I will not damage the facility or any equipment at the facility, and I will help clean up my area before I leave the facility.
- I will follow all rules and curfews set by any coaches or chaperones on away meets or training trips.
- I will refrain from using any language that is sexist, racist, homophobic, or obscene.
- I will abide by the USA Swimming Code of Conduct.
