

SANCTION: This meet is sanctioned by USA Swimming and Indiana Swimming. Sanction #IN26040

HOST: Noblesville Swim Club (NOB-IN)

LOCATION: Noblesville High School, 18111 Cumberland Road, Noblesville, IN 46060

FACILITY: The venue consists of an indoor 25 yard, 8 lane competition pool with 3 lane warm-up area in

the diving well. A Colorado timing system with touchpads will be used for this meet. The minimum water depth in accordance with Article 103.2.3 is 4  $\frac{1}{2}$  feet at the start end. The

competition course has not been certified in accordance with Article 104.2.2C(4).

Access to the facility will be through Gate 7 on the south side of the building. There is seating

for 375 in the elevated spectator area, including handicap accessible seating.

ELIGIBILITY: Swimmer(s) must be registered with USA Swimming to be accepted into this meet. Age as of

Friday, November 7, 2025, shall determine swimmer's age group for the entire meet. Indiana

Swimming does not process on-site athlete registration.

RULES: Current USA Swimming Rules, including the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"),

will govern this meet.

Coaches and officials must display their current USA Swimming coach credential or Deck Pass to gain deck access. The Meet Referee and/or Meet Director reserves the right to ask for coach credential or Deck Pass and/or deny deck access if coach does not comply or card is no

longer valid/current.

In swimming competitions, the competitor must wear only one swimsuit in one or two pieces except as provided in USA Swimming Article 205.10.1. All swimsuits shall be made from textile materials. For men, the swimsuit shall not extend above the navel nor below the knees, and for women, shall not cover the neck, extend past the shoulder, nor extend below the knee.

At a sanctioned competitive event, USA Swimming athlete members must be under the supervision of a USA Swimming member coach during warm-up, competition, and warm-down. The Meet Director or Meet Referee may assist in making arrangements for such supervision, but it is the swimmer's responsibility to make such arrangements prior to the start of the meet.

Any swimmer entered in the meet, must be certified by a USA Swimming-member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. When unaccompanied by a member-coach, it is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, restrooms, or locker rooms.

Deck changes are prohibited.



Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open-ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present. Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Program Operations Vice Chair.

FORMAT: All events are timed finals events.

The 1650 Freestyle events will be seeded fastest to slowest and alternate heats between girls and boys. The 1650 will be limited to a maximum of 3 heats, with one heat for girls, one heat for boys and one mixed heat. While it is an Open Event, entry preference will be given to swimmers by age, then time. The Meet Referee may combine heats of the 400 IM, 500 Freestyle, and 1650 Freestyle events by age and/or gender to consolidate heats.

ENTRY LIMIT: All swimmers will be limited to 5 events per day. Any entry received that is over the specified

limit will be entered in events in numerical order until the limit is reached and scratched from remaining events. There will be no refunds for events scratched due to the entry limit being

exceeded.

ENTRY FEE: The entry fee is \$7 per event. Make checks payable to Noblesville Swim Club. Submit entry

fee with a signed Release and Hold Harmless Agreement to Entry Chair or designee prior to

the start of the meet.

REFUNDS: In any meet sanctioned by Indiana Swimming other than Championship Meets, the host team

may limit the number of swimmers in any one or more events to maintain a reasonable length of the meet. If entries are limited, the host club must return the entry fees to the club(s)

whose swimmers are not allowed to compete in the specific event(s).

ENTRY PROCEDURE: All entries must be received via email by the Entry Chair. Entries or changes to entries will

only be accepted from a coach or designated entry chair from a club.

ENTRY DEADLINE: Entries will be accepted starting Monday, September 22, 2025, at 8:00 AM. Entry deadline will

be Monday, October 20, 2025, at 12:00 PM. Deadline will be extended if the meet is not full. Any accepted team entries may be updated until Monday, November 3, 2025, at 12:00 PM.

DECK ENTRIES: Deck entries will be accepted if the meet is not full only as new additions for teams already

entered in the meet. Entry fee for deck entries is \$14.00 per event.

POSITIVE CHECK-IN: There will be positive check-in for each session. Check-in sheets should be picked up by

coaches at the sign-in table prior to each session and submitted in the Control Room no later

than 15 minutes after the start of warm-up.

AWARDS: For 8&U, 9-10, and 11-12 age group events, medals will be awarded for 1st through 8th place,

ribbons will be awarded for 9<sup>th</sup> through 16<sup>th</sup> place, and high point awards will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> place. For 13-14 age group events and Open events, high point awards will be

awarded for 1st through 3rd place.

SAFETY: The safety of all participants and spectators is of the highest priority. All persons using the

facility are required to obey the facility management staff regarding safety issues. Any persons not following these instructions will be removed from further participation in the

event.

#### Safe Sport 360:

- The Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy prohibits Applicable Adults (as defined) from having one-on-one interactions with minor athletes which are not within an observable and interruptible distance from another adult. Applicable Adults are required to abide by this policy in full during this meet.
- Pursuant to USA Swimming Rules and Regulations and federal law, it is every member's responsibility to immediately (i.e., within 24 hours) report any incident of child abuse, including physical or sexual abuse, to law enforcement and the U.S. Center for SafeSport. Reporting must occur when an individual has firsthand knowledge of misconduct or where specific and credible information has been received from a victim or knowledgeable third party. Various state laws may also require reporting to law enforcement or to a designated child protection agency.
- All athletes aged 18 and older must complete Athlete Protection Training in order to be a USA Swimming registered member in good standing. Any athlete who turns 18 on or before November 7, 2025 who has not completed Athlete Protection Training by the first day of competition, will be prohibited from participating in the competition until such time as all membership requirements are completed. Times achieved by an athlete who turns age 18 on or before November 7, 2025, who competes in this USA Swimming sanctioned event without completing this membership requirement, will NOT count for qualification or recognition. This includes participation as a member of a relay.

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Locker rooms with shower and restroom are available; however, no lockers are available. Noblesville Swim Club will not be responsible for any lost or stolen items.

- Smoking and tobacco use, including vaping, are not permitted at the facility.
- Glass containers are not permitted in the pool area.
- Breakfast, lunch, and snack items will be available at the concession stand.
- Concessions and Admissions will be cashless.
- Folding chairs and other obstructions are not permitted in the spectator viewing area.
- Clerk of Course will be used for 8&U athletes.
- Heat sheets will be posted in the spectator viewing area, and available free through the Meet Mobile app and the Noblesville Swim Club website (<u>noblesvilleswim.com</u>).
