- New Members: Please join us in welcoming our two new Swimmer Representatives: Cavan Cameron and Katie Kramer.
- **COVID Update:** Within Noblesville athletic programs there has been an increase in cases of athletes transmitting COVID to other athletes versus athletes being quarantined due to outside direct contacts. Administration has not been pleased with how some athletic programs are handling COVID and because of this may be dealing with each program more severely than in the past. Despite this, Aleks has met with the AD and Principal who gave the swim team praise on how we have managed COVID, on our athletes following protocols, and how we have dealt with positive cases.
- Divisional Championships Update: Based on the information that has been provided to our club and the restrictions that would be in place from Indiana swimming, Noblesville Schools, and the health department, we have made the decision to pass on hosting this year's Divisional Championship. This is not a decision that was made lightly and was discussed at length at this past Wednesday's Board meeting. Some of the factors that played into this decision are facility space, lane space, and lack of 10 and under access to our home pool at this time. We have consistently alternated years with Fishers and they have graciously agreed to trade us years, meaning that they will host this year's meet, we will host next year's and then continue with the normal rotation with Fishers hosting in the even years and Noblesville in the odd years. Their willingness to work with us and come to this agreement is a testament to the wonderful relationship our clubs have.
