## CPSC Finishes BOTH Senior & Age Group State in 6th Place

The Crown Point Swim Club finished the 2012-2013 season with powerful performances at both the Age Group State Championships and Senior State Championships by finishing 6<sup>th</sup> at both meets. The Senior State swimmers posted a 30.43% best times while scoring a total of 526.5 team points. Aly Tetzloff won high point for the girls. Event winners and runner ups were:

At the Age Group State Championships, 22 CPSC swimmers posted a 67.65% best times effort while scoring a total of 643 team points. Hannah Kukurugya won the high point for 13-14 girls. Event winners and runner ups were:
