



Code of Conduct: Swimmers

The purpose of a code of conduct is to establish consistent expectations for behavior by our swimmers. As a swimmer, I agree with the following statements:

- ☐ I will respect and show courtesy to my teammates and coaches at all times.
- ☐ I will demonstrate good sportsmanship at all practices and meets.
- ☐ I will set a good example of behavior and work ethic for my younger teammates.
- ☐ I will be respectful of my teammates' feelings and personal space. Swimmers exhibiting sexist, racist, homophobic, or otherwise inappropriate behavior will not be tolerated.
- ☐ I will show respect for all facilities, locker rooms, and other property used during practices, competitions, and team activities.
- ☐ I will refrain from foul language, violence, behavior deemed dishonest, offense, or illegal.
- ☐ I will not consume or purchase alcohol, or tobacco.
- ☐ I will not use or possess illegal drugs or USOC banned substances of any kind.
- ☐ If I disagree with an official's call, I will talk with my coach and not approach the official directly.
- ☐ I will obey all of USA Swimming's rules and codes of conduct.
- ☐ If I have concerns, I will direct them to my coach in a courteous and productive manner.

I understand that being a member of the Greenwood Gators is a privilege, not a right, and that violation of this Swimmer's Code of Conduct may result in disciplinary action, including potential dismissal from the club.
