## Team Suit Policy Adopted May 21, 2007

All swimmers must wear a team suit to swim meets consisting of two or three teams (i.e., all dual and tri-meets), Mundelein hosted USA invitational meets, and the conference meet. Failure to meet this requirement will cause the swimmer to forfeit their opportunity to swim at that session of the meet. The head coach will have the authority to waive this requirement if circumstances occur that are beyond the control of the swimmer.

All swimmers that wear swim caps must wear a Mundelein team cap to all swim meets. If a swimmer does not have a cap during that session of the meet, a cap will be provided to them and the cost of the cap will be charged against the swimmer's escrow account.

The team suit is defined as an all black suit bearing the MMSC logo.
