Official Event Information

Entries for the 2024 Stadium Splash Presented by IU Health will be capped at approximately 400 athletes.

Athletes who have achieved a 2024 Olympic Trials qualifying time in any event are NOT eligible to compete in this meet. The 2024 Stadium Splash

Presented by IU Health, is open only to athletes who have achieved a qualifying time during the qualification period and are premium members of USA Swimming currently registered with an Indiana Swimming member club.

Entries from Indiana Swimming teams only will be accepted through USA Swimming's Online Meet Entry (OME) system beginning on Wednesday, March 27, 2024, at 8:00 AM Eastern Time. Please review all the entry procedures found on page 6 of this document.

Important Facts About the 2024 Stadium Splash Presented by IU Health

- **Meet Information:** It is the responsibility of participating swimmers and coaches to acquaint themselves with all the information contained in this document. USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will govern the conduct of this event. The meet will be conducted in LCM.
- Time Zone: Indianapolis is located in the Eastern Time Zone. All designated times are Eastern Time.
- Session Start Times: Preliminary sessions begin at 9:00 AM. Finals sessions begin at 6:00 PM.
- Format: This is a LCM competition. All events except the 800 and 1500 freestyle events will be swum in prelims-finals format with the fastest 16 athletes in prelims advancing to finals.
- Athletes: This competition is open only to Indiana Swimming registered USA Swimming member athletes who achieve the qualifying standards and are U.S. citizens eligible to represent the United States in international competition. Athletes with a 2024 Olympic Trials gualifying time are NOT eligible to compete in this meet.
- Qualification Period: The qualifying period is January 1, 2023, through the entry deadline. Qualifying standards can be found on page 3 of this document.
- Entries: All entries must be submitted through the USA Swimming Online Meet Entry system (OME). No late or deck entries will be permitted. There will be no refunds once entries are accepted. Entry questions should be directed to Trey Freeman at tfreeman@usaswimming.org
- **Bonus Events:** Swimmers with one or more qualifying times may enter up to two (2) bonus events for the meet provided they have achieved the bonus standards. There will be no bonus swims in the 800 and 1500 Freestyle events. All bonus standards are LCM only.
- Entry Deadline: Entries from Indiana Swimming teams only will be accepted beginning Wednesday, March 27, at 8:00 AM Eastern Time and will close as soon as the entry limit of approximately 400 athletes is reached, but no later than noon Eastern Time on Tuesday, May 28, 2024.
- **Meet Procedures:** Based on pre-scratch timelines, the preliminary sessions may be conducted in flights. Details regarding changes to normal meet protocol, including flighting, will be announced at the Technical Meeting.
- Race Ready/Last Call: All preliminary and finals heats will parade to the starting blocks from the Race Ready/Last Call area.
- Time Trials: If time allows, time trials will be offered each day at the end of the preliminary session. Swimmers are limited to two time trial events for the meet and three events per day including time trials. Please see pages 7, 8, & 10 for the time trials specifics.
- Relays: There will be no relays in this competition.
- Scoring: The meet will not be scored individually or by team.
- Awards: The top 3 finishers in each event will receive awards.
- Credentials: Credentials will be required for all participants in this event (athletes, coaches, officials, etc.) and will be distributed at registration. Credentials must be worn at all times. There will be an exclusive team seating area at Lucas Oil Stadium along the north side of the competition pool deck. Appropriate credentials for athletes and coaches are required for access into these sections. There will be a coaches viewing area at the top of the team seating sections.
- Competition Pool Deck: The competition pool deck will be a clean deck during all competition sessions.
- Registration: The registration area is located in Rooms 5-7 on the Event Level at Lucas Oil Stadium. Venue maps will be distributed to coaches of entered teams.
- **Technical Meeting:** The technical meeting will be on Thursday, June 6, 2024, at 5:00 PM Eastern Time in the West Club Lounge on the Street Level at Lucas Oil Stadium. This is a required meeting for coaches of all participating teams.

**Alf the 400-athlete cap has not been reached by April 10 at 11:59 PM, OME will open to Indiana Swimming member athletes with 2024 Speedo Sectional East qualifying times starting at 8:00 AM Eastern on Thursday, April 11, and close as soon as the cap is reached, but no later than noon on Tuesday, May 28.

Athletes with a 2024 Olympic Trials qualifying time are NOT eligible to compete in this meet.

Lucas Oil Stadium 500 South Capitol Avenue Indianapolis, IN 46225

About the Facility

This is a temporary venue utilizing two Myrtha pools. The competition pool has ten 50-meter lanes with a depth of 2.7M; the warm-up pool has ten 50-meter lanes and seven 25-meter lanes with a depth of 2M. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4). Starting platforms will be the same size and type as those used in the Olympic Games. Omega timing and video back-up cameras will be used in this competition. Absolutely no glass or tobacco products will be allowed in the venue.

- Spectators must enter only through the South Entrance at Lucas Oil Stadium. Doors will open 60 minutes before the start of each competition session. The stadium will not be open for spectators on Thursday during team practices.
- The NFL Clear Bag Policy will be in effect for this event. See Security on page 5 for details.
- Heat sheets will be available on Meet Mobile. Printed heat sheets for coaches will be available at the Clerk of Course/Admin Table in the Athlete Services area on the Event Level of Lucas Oil Stadium and will be posted throughout the practice and competition pool areas.

Time Zone

Indianapolis, Indiana, is located in the Eastern Time Zone. All times designated in this meet information are Eastern Time.

Pool Hours

On Thursday, event participants will have access to both the competition and warm-up pools. On competition days, access to the competition pool may be limited based on information distributed at the Technical Meeting.

Registration & Credential Pick-Up

Credentials and coach packets will be available for pick up in the registration area, Rooms 5-7 at Lucas Oil Stadium (Event Level) according to the schedule below:

Thursday, June 8 3:00 PM - 8:00 PM Friday, June 9 7:00 AM - 8:00 PM

Teams should plan to arrival at the venue during these registration hours to pick up credentials for access into the pool areas. Athletes should plan to arrive with their coaches.

All coaches desiring meet credentials must be listed on the deck pass report in OME. Coaches must present their valid coach membership cards or valid USA Swimming app screen, along with a photo ID, at registration to receive team credentials and the coach packet.

Each swimmer must be under the direct supervision of a USA Swimming member coach at all times while in the venue. Swimmers whose coaches are not present must arrange in advance for an assigned coach and plan to arrive at registration with that coach in order to obtain athlete credentials.

Credentials

Credentials will be required for all participants in this event. Athletes entered in the meet will receive a deck pass credential as part of their entry fee. Coach deck passes must be purchased through OME based on this formula (includes unattached athletes with the team):

1-3 Swimmers: 1 Deck Pass4-6 Swimmers: 2 Deck Passes

7-9 Swimmers: 3 Deck Passes

10-14 Swimmers: 4 Deck Passes15-19 Swimmers: 5 Deck Passes

15-19 Swimmers: 5 Deck Passes
 20-25 Swimmers: 6 Deck Passes

More than 25 Swimmers: 7 Deck Passes

Unattached Swimmers not with a Team: 1 Deck Pass

Credentials must be worn at all times. There will be exclusively reserved team seating areas along the north side of the competition pool. Appropriate credentials for athletes and coaches are required for access into these sections. The competition pool deck is a clean deck. There is a viewing area at the top of the team seating that is reserved exclusively for coaches to watch swimmers during their swims.

No swimmer will be issued credentials without a coach member present. If the home club coach is not planning to attend this event, the swimmer must be assigned a supervising coach as per USA Swimming rules. Arriving with a fellow LSC club/coach is preferred. However, if a swimmer arrives without a coach, he/she must find a willing coach at the facility to sign a supervision form before an athlete credential can be issued.

Restricted access to the facility will be strictly enforced beginning at 3:00 PM on Thursday, June 8. \$50.00 will be charged for credential replacements. Credentials will be required in the Ready Room for all competing athletes.

Lockers and Facilities

Lockers and facilities for athletes are located in the east corridor on the Event Level of the stadium. Athletes must provide their own locks. Lucas Oil Stadium and the meet hosts will not be held liable for lost or stolen items.

Information/Lost & Found

Lost and found for participants will be located in the Athlete Services Area at the Clerk of Course/Admin table. Spectator lost and found will be at the Guest Services kiosk located near Section 121 on the Street Level of the stadium.

Parking

- Complimentary parking for coaches, officials, and volunteers will be in the South Lot at Lucas Oil Stadium (# 25 on page 11). Head coaches will be emailed a permit for the first entry into the South Lot. Additional permits will be distributed at Registration.
- There will be an exclusive swimmer drop-off area and entrance on Capitol Avenue on the northeast corner of Lucas Oil Stadium near the Colts Pro Shop. From this location, athletes have direct access into the warm-up pool area on the Event Level of the stadium.
- There is ample parking for spectators at parking meters and in downtown-area parking facilities. (see page 11)

Security

- All participants (athletes, coaches, officials, staff, volunteers) should be prepared for bag checks upon each entry to the venue. Participants must use only their respective designated entrances.
- Any spectator bags must be clear plastic no larger than 12" x 6" x 12". Small clutch bags no larger than 4.5" x 6.5" are also permitted.

Medical Assistance

IU Health will provide on-site physician services and athletic trainers during all hours the venue is open for practice and competition. More specific information regarding these services will be distributed at the Technical Meeting.

Hospitality

Hospitality for coaches will be located near the warm-up pool in the Coach Hospitality Room (Room 4). There will be no meal service or hospitality for athletes at this event. Water will be available for athletes throughout the venue.

Hospitality for officials will be in the Officials Meeting Room in the southwest corridor of the Event Level.

Food will not be permitted on the pool deck areas.

Team Banners

No team banners will be permitted at this event.

Spectator Seating

Spectators should enter the South Entrance to Lucas Oil Stadium. Spectator seating for this event will be limited to sections 125 - 128 Tickets will only be sold online through Ticketmaster; please see page 4 for tickets sales information.

Concessions

Concessions will be available at the venue near the designated spectator seating areas during competition hours.

ELIGIBILITY & ENTRIES

Eligibility

All swimmers must be 2024 registered Premium members of USA Swimming in good standing; have met the qualifying standards within the qualifying period; be a current member of an Indiana Swimming club; and be U.S. citizens eligible to represent the U.S. in international competition. Athletes with a 2024 Olympic Trials qualifying standard are NOT eligible to compete in this meet. If an entered athlete achieves a 2024 Olympic Trials qualifying time prior to June 7, that athlete's entries will be removed from the meet.

All athletes ages 18 and older, or who turn 18 during the meet, must complete APT prior to entering the meet.

All coaches must be USA Swimming 2024 non-athlete members and present current coach certifications at registration in order to receive credentials. The representative submitting the entries shall be responsible for verifying that all swimmers and coaches satisfy these requirements.

Qualifying

The qualifying period for the 2024 Stadium Splash Presented by IU Health is January 1, 2023, through the entry deadline. Minimum qualifying standards are included in this packet with the order of events on page 3. Entry times for individual events will be accepted in long course meters and short course yards. All entries will be seeded first by long course meters, then short course yards. Swimmers with one or more qualifying times may enter up to two (2) bonus events, provided they have achieved the LCM bonus standards. There will be no bonus swims in the 800 and 1500 freestyle events. Please be sure to check the box indicating "bonus" for each event that is a bonus entry.

Entry Limits

Individual Events: Each competitor may enter as many individual events for which he/she qualifies, but may only compete in a maximum of three individual events per day including bonus events and time trials. Athletes who enter more than three events per day must scratch down by the scratch deadline for each day's events. Failure to scratch back to the three per day limit by the scratch deadline will result in the swimmer being scratched from all events except the first three entered on any given day. There will be no refund of entry fees.

Relays: There will be no relays in this meet.

Entry Fees

- \$20 per individual event and time trials individual event
- \$20 per credentialed coach (\$25 on site)

Entry Procedures

All entries for this meet must be submitted using the USA Swimming Online Meet Entry (OME) system. No paper or email entries will be accepted; there will be no late or on-deck registration at this meet. OME can be accessed through the SWIMS database at: hub.usaswimming.org.

- OME will open to Indiana Swimming athletes who have achieved the qualifying times listed page 3 of this document beginning at 8:00 AM ET on Wednesday, March 27, 2024.
- If the cap has not been reached by 11:59 PM on Wednesday, April 10, OME will open to Indiana Swimming athletes who have achieved 2024 Central Zone East Speedo Sectional qualifying times at 8:00 AM on Thursday, April 11, and will close as soon as the cap is reached but no later than noon on Tuesday, May 28, 2024.
- An athlete is not considered entered in the meet until the checkout process in OME has been completed and payment

has been made.

The OME system processes payment by credit card and will accept Visa, MasterCard, American Express, and Discover. Upon payment, a confirmation email providing a receipt and summary of entries will be sent. Please bring a copy of all entry communications with you to the meet.

OME is not an eligibility report. Coaches are responsible for knowing events for which their athletes are qualified.

Entries are not officially accepted into the meet until the user has paid and checked out of OME. The first 400 qualified swimmers to check out of OME will be accepted into this meet. At that time, OME will be shut down and entries closed. Once entries are accepted, there will be no refunds.

The USA Swimming Waiver and Release Form will automatically be generated by OME. These forms must be submitted at Registration upon arrival at Lucas Oil Stadium to obtain meet credentials. Having this completed will save time during check-in at Registration. A parent or legal guardian must sign the form if the swimmer is under the age of majority in his/her home state.

Drug waiver forms will automatically be sent via email after on-line entries are submitted. Please fill these out and bring them with you to the meet/

Proof of Time

Times submitted to the USA Swimming SWIMS database will be available for entries. If a time for a swimmer is visible in the public search feature on the USA Swimming website (Times/Time Standards) and it was swum in the appropriate qualifying period, it is considered a proven official time. Entry times not proven by the scratch deadline for the event will be considered as false or incorrect times and are subject to action under provisions of the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations.

No swimmer will be permitted to swim without proof of time. USA Swimming reserves the right to challenge any submitted time. All scratches must be proven at the Resolution Desk.

Image Authorization

All participants agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and network(s) of USA Swimming under the conditions authored by USA Swimming, and allow event organizers the right to use names, pictures, likenesses, and biographical information before, during or after the period of participation in USA Swimming competitions to promote such competitions. All participants agree not to use or authorize use of pictures in the uniforms and equipment provided by USA Swimming for the purpose of trade, without the consent of USA Swimming. All participants agree not to use awards or photos, or portraits or films with the awards, which are received for performances in this competition, for the purpose of trade. Furthermore, participants agree to return these uniforms and equipment, bearing USA Swimming logos and marks, if and when requested.

All photographs, videotape, or other audio and/or visual recordings of the event created by a spectator may be used solely for such spectator's personal non-commercial use, and may not be broadcast, published, or disseminated, or used for any commercial purposes without the prior written consent of USA Swimming.

MEET PROCEDURES

Rules

The most current version of USA Swimming Rules and Regulations will govern the conduct of the 2024 Stadium Splash Presented by IU Health and will serve as the official guide for technical and procedural rules. It shall be the swimmers' and coaches' responsibility to acquaint themselves with those rules and regulations and other information contained in this meet announcement.

Any swimmer entered in the meet must be certified by a USA Swimming member-coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of te swimmer or the swimmer's legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

It is understood and agreed that USA Swimming, the Indiana Sports Corp, Lucas Oil Stadium, the Local Organizing Committee, volunteers, officials, and the LSC shall be free from any liabilities or claims for damages arising by reason of injuries to anyone during the conduct of the event.

Meet Format

This meet will be conducted in long course meters and is a two-day competition with prelims and finals sessions each day. There are no relays in this meet. At the discretion of the Meet Referee, prelims may be flighted using 10 lanes; finals will be conducted using eight lanes.

<u>Preliminary & Final Events:</u> All events except the 800 freestyle and the 1500 freestyle will be swum in a prelims-finals format with preliminary sessions in the morning (9:00 AM) and finals sessions in the evening (6:00 PM). The fastest 16 athletes in the prelims session will advance to A and B heats in finals; the B heat in each event will swim first followed by the A heat.

<u>Timed Final Events:</u> The fastest seeded heat of the 800 freestyle and the1500 freestyle events is the first event in finals with the remaining heats swum at the end of prelims, fastest to slowest, alternating women and men.

Warm-Ups and Safety

Current USA Swimming Rules will govern all aspects of the warmup. During warm-up sessions, athletes must enter the water feet first except in designated lanes and times.

A separate ten-lane 50-meter and seven-lane 25-meter pool will be available for warm-up and cool-down throughout the competition.

- At least two lanes (one 50 M and one 25 M) will be designated as pace lanes, push off only, circle swimming only.
- At least two lanes (one 50 M and one 25 M) will be designated as one-way sprint lanes.
- Two lanes of the warm-up pool (one 50 M and one 25 M) will be available for bungee cord use upon request. No bungee cords or hand paddles will be allowed in the competition pool.
- All other lanes will be designated for general warm-up, circle swimming only. Upon request and at the discretion of meet officials, these designations may be altered.
- A complete schedule of warm-up procedures, including lane usage and times, can be found on Page 9. This schedule will also be distributed in the coaches' packets at Registration, discussed at the Technical Meeting, and announced throughout the venue on a regular basis.
- Participants are expected to cooperate with the meet marshals.
 Flagrant violations of these procedures may result in disqualification from the athlete's next individual event or expulsion from the meet for unsportsmanlike conduct.

Race Ready/Last Call:

All preliminary and finals heats will parade to the starting blocks from the Ready Room/Last Call Room. Swimmers must report to the Ready Room with their credentials no later than ten minutes prior to their events. Credentials will be collected prior to each heat and returned immediately following the heat.

Positive Check-In

The 800 and 1500 freestyle events require positive check-in at the Clerk of Course/Admin table by the scratch deadline for that event in order to be seeded. Failure to do so will result in the athlete being seeded in the slowest conforming heat.

Scratch Rules

USA Swimming National Championships scratch procedures will be in effect for this meet. Please refer to section 207.11.6 in the USA Swimming Rulebook for specific scratch penalties.

Scratch Procedures and Deadlines

Before and after the Technical Meeting, the scratch box will be located at the Clerk of Course/Admin table in the Athlete Services Area. The scratch box will be available at the Technical Meeting.

The scratch deadline for Friday's events will be 15 minutes after the adjournment of the Technical Meeting on Thursday. The scratch deadlines for Saturday events will be at 6:30 PM on Friday evening.

Payment for scratched events is not refundable.

Seeding

In individual events, seeding priority will be as follows: LCM first-seeding priority; SCY second-seeding priority. Only LCM qualifying times will be accepted for bonus events.

Time Trials

Long course time trials will be conducted on a time-available basis between prelims and finals each day and are limited to one hour in length. Time trials will begin 30 minutes after the conclusion of prelims. The time trial event order is as follows:

- Friday and Saturday: That day's events followed by the remaining events in the meet
- The 800 and 1500 freestyle will be offered only on one day of the meet. The day will be determined by the Meet Referee, depending on the size of the meet, time available, etc., and will be announced at the Technical Meeting.
- The 50 freestyle is the last event swum in time trials except on the day it is contested in the meet, when it is the first event in time trials.
- See page 10 for complete time trial order.

Swimmers must be entered in the meet to compete in time trials. Time trial events count toward the daily entry limit of three events. A swimmer is limited to a maximum of two time trials during the course of this meet.

Teams will receive more information on Time Trials in their registration packets and at the Technical Meeting.

MEET PROCEDURES - Continued

Time Trials - Continued

Entries for time trials will be accepted at the Clerk of Course/ Admin table (located in the Athlete Services Area) until one hour before the scheduled end of the prelims session each day; this time will be posted at the Clerk of Course/Admin table. The entry fee for time trials is \$20 per individual event payable by credit card only. Refunds will be issued if sufficient time is not available to conduct the time trial session. All times achieved in time trials will appear in the published meet results.

Coach Meetings

There will be an optional "Know Before You Go" virtual meeting on Tuesday evening, June 4, at 7:00 PM to acquaint coaches with the venue protocols and layout.

The required Technical Meeting will be at 5:00 PM, Thursday, June 6, in the West Club Lounge of Lucas Oil Stadium (Street Level). Coaches are responsible for all business conducted at the Technical Meeting. If, for any reason, you cannot attend the Technical Meeting, be sure to make arrangements to find out what occurred. Coaches must arrive prior to the scratch deadline for a swimmer's first event to prove times if necessary. Details of any changes to the procedures outlined above will be announced at the meeting.

The scratch deadline for Friday's events is 15 minutes after the adjournment of the Technical Meeting on Thursday.

Scoring

The meet will not be scored individually or by team.

Awards

The top three (3) finishers in each event will receive awards at the medal ceremony following each race. Detailed information regarding the awards presentation schedule will be distributed at the Technical Meeting.

Results

Results will be available online at omegatiming.com and on Meet Mobil.

Individual event results will be available at the Clerk of Course/Admin table upon request.

USA Swimming Broadcast Policy

Any photographs, videotape, or other audio and/or visual recordings of the event created by a spectator may be used solely for such spectator's personal non-commercial use, and may not be broadcast, published or disseminated, or used for any commercial purposes without the prior written consent of USA Swimming.

Safe Sport

The Safe Sport program is USA Swimming's comprehensive abuse prevention program dedicated to reducing the risk of sexual, emotional and physical abuse to athletes. Components of the program include, but are not limited to, providing education and training, enforcing policies (such as the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy), rules and best practice guidelines, promoting healthy boundaries and mandated reporting of violations.

Pursuant to USA Swimming Rules and Regulations and federal law, it is every member's responsibility to immediately (i.e., within 24 hours) report any incident of child abuse, including physical or sexual abuse, to law enforcement and the U.S. Center for SafeSport. Reporting must occur when an individual has firsthand knowledge of misconduct or where specific and credible information has been received from a victim or knowledgeable third party. A report to the U.S. Center for SafeSport may be made via telephone at 833-SUS-SAFE (833-587-7233) or online at www.uscenterforsafesport.org/report-aconcern. Various state laws may also require reporting to law enforcement or to a designated child protection agency.

All individual age 18 and older participating in or associated with this meet acknowledge that they are subject to provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy (MAAPP) and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a precondition of participation in the conduct of this meet. The Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy prohibits adult participants from having one-on-one interaction with minor athletes that is not within an observable and interruptible distance from another adult participant. All adult participants in or associated with this meet acknowledge they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming MAAPP, and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP Policy is a condition of participation in this competition.

All athletes ages 18 and older must complete Athlete Protection Training (APT) to be a USA Swimming registered member in good standing. Any athlete age 18 or older, or who turns 18 during the meet, who has not completed Athlete Protection Training will be prohibited from participating. Times achieved by an athlete age 18 and older, or by an athlete who turns age 18 during the competition, and who competes in this USA Swimming sanctioned event without completing this membership requirement, will NOT count for qualification or recognition. This includes participation as a member of a relay.

The requirement to complete Athlete Protection Training is an annual requirement. USA Swimming membership will be affected if a non-athlete member or adult athlete member does not renew Athlete Protection Training annually.

All U.S. athletes, coaches, and staff expecting to receive a deck pass should be prepared to show proof of current USA Swimming membership. Coaches must meet and have current certifications for all the requirements of coach membership including successfully passing the required background check and APT course.

Recording devices (cell phones, cameras, PDAs, etc.) are not permitted behind the starting blocks during the entire meet.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or designated changing areas is prohibited.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas, and open ceiling locker rooms any time athletes, coaches, officials, and/or spectators are present.

Adjustments to warm-up times may be made by the Meet Referee and announced at the Technical Meeting.

General Considerations:

- During the last hour of warm-up prior to each session, only swimmers competing in that session may warm-up in the competition pool.
- Please follow the established schedule. If you believe special circumstances exist or additional sprint lanes are needed, please contact the meet officials on deck.
- Coaches should maintain contact with their swimmers as much as practical verbally and visually throughout the warm-up period.
- No bungee cord or hand paddle use will be permitted in the competition pool.
- Swimmers should not step up on the blocks when a backstroker is preparing to start.
- Swimmers and coaches, please cooperate with marshals regarding these procedures.

SCHEDULE: WARM-UP POOL

- The warm-up pool will be available for all competing athletes continuously throughout the day during the published venue hours.
- At least two lanes (one 50 M and one 25 M) will be designated as pace lanes; push off only; circle swimming only.
- At least two lanes (one 50 M and one 25 M will be designated as one-way sprint lanes.
- Two lanes (one 50 M and one 25 M) will be available for bungee cord use upon request.
- All other lanes will be designated for general warm-up; circle swimming only.
- Upon request and at the discretion of meet officials, these lane designations may be altered.

- 7) More specific information regarding the availability of time trials will be announced at the Technical Meeting.
- 8) *The 800 and 1500 Freestyle will be offered only one day of the meet. The day will be determined by the Meet Referee and will be announced at the Technical Meeting.
