Annual Training Fee

Swim families who sign up for a full-year membership, **which begins on Sept. 5, 2023 and ends Aug. 31, 2024**, will have their annual training fee broken down into eight monthly payments and receive a year of swim club training. Invoices will be emailed monthly around the 1st of each month. **Once you have registered for the team, you are responsible for a year's fees regardless of participation**.

Six-Month Training Fee

Swim families who sign up for a six-month membership, which begins Oct. 1, 2023 and ends March 31, 2024, will have their Six-Month Training Fee broken down into six monthly payments. Invoices will be emailed monthly around 1st of each month. Once you have registered for the half-year team, you are responsible for a Six Month's Training fees regardless of participation. Please note Six-Month membership is only available for Group A, Group B, Silver and Bronze swimmers. Gold and Senior swimmers are not eligible for the Six-Month Training option due to the level of their competition training.

Late Fees and Payments

Whether you choose the full-year or six-month membership, you are responsible for total team fees associated with that membership. There is no month-to-month participation with either plan. All payments must be received by the 20th of each month or a late fee of \$25 will be incurred. Payments are required to be made via Team Unify automated system. Each account requires a credit/debit card to be associated with the account to cover fees each month.

Discounted Fees

- 10% Reduction on Annual Training Fee if Paid in full by September 10th*
- 5% Reduction on Annual Training Fee if Paid in 2 Installments due by September 10th & January 10th*
- 10% Reduction on 1st Additional Club Member**
- 20% Reduction on 2nd Additional Club Member**
- *This discount only applies to the full year/annual training fee. Six-month participants are not eligible.
- **This discount only applies to the full year/annual training fee that is broken down into 8 monthly payments. The paid-in-full option or 2 installments is not eligible for the additional club member discount as well.

CKA Club Fee & USA Registration Fee

 USA Registration Fees are paid directly to USA Swimming. You will receive an email upon registration with a link to register with USA Swimming directly. The fee you will pay to USA Swimming is \$99.



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- For those families who are eligible; there is an Outreach USA/KY Swimming Membership. It is a reduction in USA/KY Swimming Membership Fees. Please request more info if you feel your family is eligible.
- The annual CKA Club Fee of \$100, which is due at the time of sign ups, covers administration fees for the Team Unify system that manages all of our communication within the team, two team T-shirts, and a team swim cap.

Stroke Clinic Credit

After completing the stroke clinic, if a swimmer joins CKA for the first time and with a full-year membership, their Stroke Clinic payment will be credited toward their Annual Training Fee. Returning CKA members will not be eligible. Credits for stroke clinic will not be eligible if it is a six-month membership.

Fundraising

Each Central Kentucky Aquatic Family has a fundraising requirement per swimmer. The family will fulfill this requirement by participating in fundraising events, by paying the full amount, or by adding it to your monthly payment of team fees. There will be several fundraising events available to help meet the requirements. All fundraising will be due by March 25, 2024. Any fundraising earned after March 25, 2024, will be credited to your following year's fundraising requirement.

Full Membership Fundraising Fees

Families with 1 Swimmer are required to raise \$250. Families with 2 Swimmers are required to raise \$350. Families with 3 Swimmers are required to raise \$375.

Six-Month Membership Fundraising Fees

Families with 1 Swimmer are required to raise \$125. Families with 2 Swimmers are required to raise \$175. Families with 3 Swimmers are required to raise \$190.

Additional Expenses

These are expenses associated with membership that include, but not limited to, meet entry fees, apparel, events, etc. Once meet entries have been sent to the host team, an invoice will be generated for those events to your account. Regardless of participation in the meet at that point, you will be responsible for meet fees. If for some reason the host team doesn't charge CKA for those entries that you don't swim, a credit will be applied to your account. If your swimmer skips or misses an event at the swim meet, you still will be charged for that event. Along with meet fees, a \$25 travel fee per away meet will be required for a partial coverage of coaching travel fees during the season. Additional expenses will be invoiced the month following any expense is incurred. Individual invoices will be generated for your review.

Volunteer Commitment

Each Central Kentucky Aquatic Family has a volunteer requirement. The family will fulfill this requirement by volunteering at events such as swim meets, social functions, fundraising opportunities, etc. Families will be responsible for a certain number of volunteer credits during the short course and long course seasons. The number of credits each family is required to earn is based upon the assigned training group of the swimmer. The credit requirements are the same whether you have a full membership or a six-month membership.

- 10 credits for Bronze or Group B;
- 15 credits for Silver or Group A;
- 20 credits for Gold or Senior.

If a family has more than one swimmer, the training group of the highest level swimmer will be used to determine these credits. Families that fail to fulfill this commitment or prefer to opt-out of the volunteer requirement will be billed \$10 per unearned credit at the end of each season.
