Meet Expectations

- * Participation in all Home Meets
- * Strongly encourage ALL swimmers that have been swimming for a year or more to participate in at least 75 percent of the meets offered.
- * For example, Bowling Green can be driven easily and does not require an overnight stay.
- * The Coaches and Board support attendance at these meets. On Saturdays when meets are scheduled, your swimmer will not have practice. Friday schedules will be altered as necessary.

Volunteer Policies

A family member (consists of parent, stepparent, grandparent, sibling OR whoever you choose to represent your family) of a swimmer(s) must work a total of at least THREE (3) SESSIONS at each hosted swim meet. For each of the three sessions a family member/representative does not work at a hosted meet, a fine of \$50 PER SESSION (up to \$150 total per meet) will apply. Sign-in sheets will be at the gate admission table and all volunteers must sign in to receive credit for working the meet sessions.

It is understandable that from time to time there are extenuating circumstances that prevent families from complying with this Volunteer Policy. In the case of a true emergency (i.e. death in the family, serious illness, etc.) families should contact the Volunteer Coordinator on a timely basis with the reason they are unable to work a meet and the Volunteer Coordinator will contact the Board President for an excused absence. If not a true emergency but a family simply cannot work because of other obligations such as being out of town, at another sporting event for another child, etc., the family should notify the Volunteer Coordinator to make arrangements to donate food/cash to go toward the hospitality room. The recommended donation value should be approximately \$75.

Swim Officials No officials = No swimming

We need 10% of our membership in officials.

We are lost 3 to 5 MAIN officials in the next year.

You do not have to have prior experience in swimming to be an official. There is a clinic, a test, a background check, and shadowing that needs to be completed to become an official.

- Yearly Fee \$93 fee for annual USA Swimming Fee
- * One-time administrative fee for account set-up (\$35).
- * Monthly Dues Based on the group that your child is placed:
- * Marlins Development \$70/month
- * Age Group Development \$80/month
- * Age Group Performance \$90/month
- * Age Group Elite \$95/month
- * Performance \$100/month
- * Senior \$105/month
- * Senior Prep \$110/month
- * Senior Elite \$120/month
- * There is a discount for multiple children in one family

Methods of Payments

Preferred method of payment is automatic draft from checking account

Automatic draft from checking account or credit card

- * Credit card payments and checking account drafts occur on the first day of each month.
- * <u>Very Important</u> If you know that your swimmer will dropping from the team for some period of time, please let the treasurer/coach know as soon as possible to avoid the auto draft or card charge.
- * <u>Very Important</u> If your swimmer swims at least two weeks in a month, you will be billed for the entire month.
- * Monthly Dues are automatically withdrawn on the 1st of each month.


