**TEAM ELIGIBILITY:** The 2025 Conference Championship is a closed competition. All teams must be a paid member of the Conference AND attend 3 conference meets prior to the Championship meet. An eligible meet must be hosted by a RRHSSC member team.

**SWIMMER ELIGIBILITY:** Each swimmer must be a currently enrolled high school student at a LHSAA member school who is academically eligible and not yet reached his/her 19th birthday.

#### RULES:

LHSAA 20.3.3 "The current NFHS Swimming rules shall govern the order of events, scoring and rules for contestants." The Official 2025 National Federation of State High School Associations rule book will be used in accordance with the championship meet. All <a href="mailto:swimmers">swimmers</a>' names, <a href="mailto:school">school</a> and <a href="mailto:grade">grade</a> must appear on the master entry sheet or Hv-tek file.

If a swimmer misses an event for any reason, they are no longer eligible to compete in any following events for the remainder of the meet.

Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms, locker rooms or behind the blocks

Changing into or out of swimsuits other than in locker rooms or other designated areas is prohibited.

A meet review committee consisting of at least one official, one coach, and one athlete will be appointed by the Meet Referee to review conflicts arising from administrative matters.

#### **FORMAT:**

Timing assignments will be assigned after all entries are received. Each assigned school is responsible to cover their designated timing assignment.

Preliminaries and Finals will be contested in all events.

The last three heats of each preliminary event will be circle seeded. EXCEPTION: Only the last two heats of the 500 free will be circle seeded in prelims.

There will be 2 heats for each event at finals and will be swum slowest to fastest. The heat sheet for finals events will list 2 alternates. Alternate swimmers must check in with the Referee and be positioned at the starting area to be eligible for a finals swim.

There will be a ready room utilized for all finals events.

At the discretion of the meet Referee, the preliminary session may be conducted using flyover starts.

**ENTRIES**: A competitor shall be permitted to enter a maximum of four (4) events, no more than two (2) of which may be individual events. For prelims only, a swimmer may enter a third individual event if their team does not have enough swimmers for relays. The event designated as exhibition is **NOT** eligible to move on to finals.

Only 4 individual swimmers per school may advance to the finals. Only one relay team per school may advance to finals.

All swimmers should be entered with a current time in order to ensure proper seeding (NT entries are strongly discouraged).

Teams may send in entries using the Hy-Tek program or on the enclosed entry sheets.

# No deck entries or adds will be accepted.

**RELAY SPLIT REQUESTS:** All relay lead off split requests must be submitted 30 minutes before the start of the session by filling out a split request form. Coaches must provide two additional stopwatches for the lead off swimmer, record the times on the provided form and turn the watches and form into the referee.

#### PRELIMS FACILITY:

Indoor, heated, eight lane 50 Meter pool. Non-turbulent lane lines, lane width 8 feet. Warmup/warmdown area available. Starting block wedges, and Colorado back stroke start devices. Evacuator Air System, UV Water Filtration.

Pool Measurement and Depth: The competition pool has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C (4). The water depth as measured from 1 meter from the wall to 5 meters from the wall is as follows: Start end: 9' Turn End: 5.5'

Timing: Colorado Timing System 7. Eighteen touchpads, 2 electronic starters, and a scoreboard. The primary system will be a touchpad. The secondary system will be manual with two buttons and two digital watches per lane.

#### FINALS FACILITY:

Indoor, heated 25 yard indoor pool, with attached warm-up/warm down lane. Eight lanes with non-turbulant lane lines and Finis back stroke start wedges.

Water Depth: The water depth at the start is 13'0"; 15 meters from the start the depth is 11'11". At the turn the depth is 4'6"; at 15 meters from the turn the depth is 5'0".

Pool Certification: The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2C(4) and the copy is on file with USA Swimming.

Timing: The primary timing system will be Colorado Swim VI, with touch pads and one back-up button. The button will serve as a secondary system. A third system will be two (2) handheld stopwatches in each lane. Teams will be required to provide timers.

**UNIFORMS:** Only one swimsuit may be worn (no double suiting). Competitors may NOT wear or use any type of brace, aid, or tape(including kinesiology tape) without medical documentation that is presented to the referee before the start of the competition. Swim caps can only represent the team's school or be blank (no other logos).

**SCORING:** The meet will be scored to 16th place for individual events and relays. Scoring will be as follows:

Individual Events: 20, 17, 16, 15, 14, 13, 12, 11, 9, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1 Relay Events: 40, 34, 32, 30, 28, 26, 24, 22, 18, 14, 12, 10, 8, 6, 4, 2

**AWARDS:** Awards for the RRHSSC Championship Meet will be medals for 1st - 3rd places and ribbons for 4th through 16th places.

Trophies will be awarded for the 1st and 2nd place male and female teams. A team trophy will be awarded to the team with the top combined score.

Seniors will be presented with a commemorative participation award.

Coaches will vote on Female Swimmer of the Conference, Male Swimmer of the Conference, Conference Coach of the Year, and the Team Sportsmanship Award which will be presented at the conclusion of Finals.

**HEAT SHEETS:** Heat sheets will be sold separately for prelims and finals

#### **USA SWIMMERS**

This is a USA sanctioned and observed meet. All currently registered USA swimmers must have their *legal name*, *date of birth and USA ID number* entered in the meet for their results to be sent in.

Please use the included separate form for USA swimmers with all of their required information to have their results sent in OR confirm it is included on your Hy-Tek entry file.
