Lincoln Parish High School Swim Teams

Purpose of the Team

The purpose of high school swimming is to provide the opportunity for each swimmer to reach their potential in the sport of competitive swimming, while having fun competing as a part of the team. Our team provides a healthy environment in which each swimmer can enjoy the sport, make lasting friendships, and develop a positive self-image.

Eligibility

- 9th 12th grade students at Ruston and Choudrant High Schools
- 7th 12th grade students from Cedar Creeks Schools
- Home- school students are also allowed to participate (must complete Parish paperwork)
- No previous knowledge of competitive swimming, but they must be able to swim independently
- All athletes are required to have the proper paperwork on file at their school (physical, insurance forms, etc.)

Try-outs

- There will be try-outs
- There are multiple options to make the varsity team
 - Maintain 75% summer practice attendance
 - Successfully complete a try-out set in July at the end of summer practices
 - Successfully complete a try-out set on the first day of practice
 - A separate try-out time may be scheduled by contacting the coach

<u>Season</u>

- Swimming is during the fall sports season
- August 11, 2025 November 22, 2025
- There will be practices and meets during fall break (required as part of team attendance)

In Season Practices

- High school age team members will be given 7th hour athletic PE in their school class schedules
 - 7th 8th grade students cannot practice in the athletic PE timeslot, they will have a different schedule available
- Ruston students will walk from the HS to the Lambright Center for practices
- Other schools, parents must provide transportation

- Athletes are expected to practice everyday and their grade is based on practice attendance
- There will separate before school weight sessions as part of the practice schedule
- Swimmers are to provide their own practice gear: suit, cap, goggles, fins, paddles

Summer Practice Option

- Current and future team members have the option to participate in HS summer training
- This is done through the Bulldog Aquatic Club
- Please contact the coach or office for more information

<u>Fees</u>

There are separate team fees to be determined at a later date.

Swim Gear

Swimmers will be required to provide their own goggles (must be competition type goggles). Name brands, like SPEEDO or TYR are recommended. Suits are to be either one-piece suits for girls or jammers or briefs for boys. Team suits can be purchased online, and more information will be given on how to order at a later date. We will also provide a swim cap for each swimmer, which can be used for practice and for meets.

Meets

- The dates for the meets will be available sometime in August
- In the past, all regular season meets were on Saturdays
- Parents will be responsible for transportation to and from all swim meets
- Parents will be asked to serve as volunteers at the meets
