Age Group Vice Chair Report

1. 2019 Midwest All-Stars - Elkhorn, NE
 - a. Coaches: Kate Davey -head coach, Karyl Palmer, Tom Young. Will get coach's contract out to them in the next 2 weeks.
 - b. 1/19/2019 and 1/20/2019, with team pictures and team warm-up on 1/18/2019.
 - c. Currently working with Splash on t-shirt design, as well as Team Iowa traveling banner.
 - d. Registration will be open on Monday, 11/5/218 and will go through midnight 12/6/2018. Meet information up to this point will go out on 11/5/2018 as well.
 - i. Event qualifying period: 9/1 to 12/16/2018.
 - ii. Swimmers will register and commit to the meet only. We will build the team/choose the events for swimmers.
 - iii. Team will be built as it has in previous years.
 1. Once registration closes (see registration info above), the team will be built starting with the top three committed athletes to the meet, in each event. If the 60 athlete limit and/or the 5 entry limit is not yet achieved the team will look at top four times, then top five times etc. Once the 60 athlete limit is reached, additional entries based upon the 5 entries/event will be filled only with existing team members. This may result in entries where a faster time in the LSC exists.
 - iv. Team to be build the week of 12/17/18 with the goal to let families know by week's end.
 - e. Hotel room blocks are just about set and should be completed midweek.
 - i. Two hotels, both about 10 minutes from the pool.
 - ii. 62 rooms reserved. Will reserve coaches rooms this week.
 - f. No meet information yet, however host changing meet slightly
 - i. Missouri is coming back to the meet, therefore teams are allowed 60 athletes.
 - ii. Swimmers can now swim 7 events for the weekend.
 - iii. LSC still able to enter 5 athletes per event.
