New Business

Updates to IASI Section I Policies and Procedures in response to Covid-19 and return to competition

Approval of these proposals were done by block voting. Proposals pulled for discussion were Proposals 1, 3, 4, 5, and 7. The vote to approve the proposals not pulled was then held.

Motion by Tanja Avant to approve Proposals 2 and 6 as presented. Seconded by Brian Ruffles.

Motion carried.

<u>Proposal 1:</u> A motion was made to amend the proposal as presented to the following:

Amendment of Section I.V. Meet Sanctioning A.3 Initial Draft Deadlines Initial Draft Deadlines. First drafts of meet announcement must be emailed or mailed to the Admin. Vice Chair and ISI Administrative Office no later than the following dates:

Invitationals Minimum $\underline{\bf 5}$ days before the meet starts Closed competition (Duals,Intrasquad,Triangular,etc.) Minimum $\underline{\bf 5}$ days before the meet starts

These dates are deadlines. A meet host will be assessed a \$20 fine if the first draft of its meet announcement is received after these due dates.

Motion by Phil Barnes to approve amended proposal . Seconded by Brian Ruffles. **Motion carried.**

<u>Proposal 3:</u> Suspension of the following phrase within Section I. VII. Specific Meet Operating Rules B.1.: Meet entries are to be accepted no later than 30 days before the start of the meet

Discussion clarified that as currently stated, a team must open up entries for a meet at least 30 days prior to the start of the meet. This deadline is not feasible for meets run during the Covid-19 pandemic.

Motion by Dan Lake to approve proposal as presented. Seconded by Mike Peterson.

Motion carried.

This policy will be in effect during the period defined as the Covid-19 timeframe until the Board meets to reinstate the original policy.

<u>Proposal 4</u>: Suspension of Section I. VII. Specific Meet Operating Rules B. 8 ISI Swimmer Surcharge

Discussion was held about the need to place a final date on this proposal. Board voted on 4/28/2020 to suspend collection of Splash Fees until September 1, 2020.

Motion by Phil Barnes to approve proposal as presented. Seconded by Brian Ruffles. **Motion carried.**

This policy will be in effect during the period defined as the Covid-19 timeframe until the Board meets to reinstate the original policy.

<u>Proposal 5:</u> A motion was made to amend the proposal as presented to the following:

Amendment of Section I. VII. Specific Meet Operating Rules. B.9 <u>Facilty Fee.</u> Meet hosts may collect an additional surcharge per swimmer to offset facility fees or other meet expenses, except for intrasquad and dual meets wherein no more than \$5.00 per swimmer may be charged in lieu of individual event entry fees.

Motion by Mike Peterson to approve proposal as amended. Seconded by Brian Ruffles.

Motion carried.

<u>Proposal 7:</u> A motion was made to amend the proposal as presented to the following:

Spectator Fees. A meet host may charge a spectator fee if the meet has qualifying standards faster than the ISLQ time standard.

Discussion was held as to whether this would place a hardship on families financially impacted by the Covid-19 pandemic. A cap on spectator fees was discussed and deemed not necessary. "Spectator fee" was clarified and defined as a fee charged for physical entry of a spectator to an event or a fee charged to access a live-stream of the event.

Motion by Phil Barnes to approve proposal as amended. Seconded by Mike Peterson.

Motion carried.

This policy will be in effect during the period defined as the Covid-19 timeframe until the Board meets to reinstate the original policy.

Recommendations from IASI Technical Planning Committee regarding Warm-up Procedures (see attached document)

Discussion held as to whether this document should be adopted as rule or just recommendation during the Covid-19 pandemic. TPC will continue refining these Warm-up procedures and recommends their use during Covid-19.

<u>Proposal to remove Section e</u> from Section I. VII. Specific Meet Operating Rules M.3.e. General Warm-Up Period

- e. <u>General Warm-up Period.</u> The meet host is to provide the following general warm-up periods prior to commencing competition:
- i.A minimum 50 minute swimming period prior to clearing the pool for swimmers age 13 & over.
- ii.A minimum 40 minute swimming period prior to clearing the pool for all swimmers age 12 and under.
- iii.A minimum of 30 minutes for intra-squad and dual meets.
- iv.The meet's referee may determine when the general warm-up ends and lanes can be switched to start lanes, pace lances, and push-start lanes. For 13 & over sessions, at least one lane must remain open for push and pace lanes and one lane will remain open general warm-up at all times. For 12 & under sessions, at least one lane must remain open for general warm-ups.
- v.All general warm-up lanes will use circle swimming and push off only.
- vi.All swimmers shall enter the water and begin swimming at the starting end of the
- vii.Starts are not permitted during the general warm-up period. viii.Swimmers congregated at the end of lanes blocking circle swimming will be asked to either circle swim or leave the water.
