

2022 Spring HOD Safe Sport Report

Saturday Legislative Review Session at 2022 USA Swimming National Workshop – Denver, CO

Discussion of proposed legislation for September Annual meeting. Registration/Safe Sport related topics:

102.10.3 – To standardize the minimum number of meet marshals at sanctioned meets.

2 Marshals (~~number determined by LSC~~), with at least one of each gender.

Discussion included points regarding

- liability of club, organization, and facility if meet marshalls are not required and properly trained.
- Whether it is appropriate to require one of each gender, or whether it is more practical and inclusive to simply require 2 marshalls of any gender.
- Burden on clubs already stretched with volunteer requirements

204.4.11 – To require that all meets sanctioned by the LSC follow the approved quality control system approved by the US Center for Safe Sport.

- US Center for Safe Sport is soon going to *require* a quality control system for meets. USA Swimming already offers a *recommended* system - Meet 360 - which has been available for several years. Particular points within Meet 360 will now be required- details to come.
