Race Day Information

Warmup	Preliminary warmup time will take place between turns 2 and 3 of the course. Once racing has begun, additional warmup time may be utilized in the enclosed area between the start & finish segments.
Safety Procedures	 Please make sure that fingernails and toenails are trimmed and all jewelry/watches are removed prior to registration. All swimmers must report to the registration area to check in before they swim to pick up their ID card, get their race number, and have their nails checked. The Clerk of Course must be notified of any athlete scratching the race after completing registration. Swimmers should wear their team caps during all portions of the race. The course will be patrolled by lifeguards and volunteers trained in water safety. Additional water rescue support details will be communicated in the pre-race safety briefing. A full listing will be available on the meet page. The race will not be escorted. In the event of adverse conditions, meet management will host a coaches meeting to discuss potential options. All swimmers must finish within 20 minutes of the first swimmer in their wave. Swimmers still in the water after that point may be removed from the course.

MAAPP & Meet Conduct

MAAPP	All applicable adults participating in or associated with this meet, acknowledge that they are subject to the provisions of the USA Swimming Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policy ("MAAPP"), and that they understand that compliance with the MAAPP policy is a condition of participation in the conduct of this competition. A registered athlete member at a sanctioned/approved meet who is 18 years of age or older, who had not completed the Athlete Protection Training (APT) by the date of the swim, will not be able to upload into SWIMS. These athletes will also be considered "not in good standing" and can be subject to fines under Wisconsin Swimming Policy 11.2.1. All coaches and staff expecting to receive a deck pass should be prepared to show current USA Swimming Membership.
Meet Conduct	Each club is responsible for the conduct of its swimmers. Any person who, in the opinion of the Meet Director or Meet Marshal, is harmful to others or to other's property may be required to leave the competition. Deck changes are prohibited. Use of audio or visual recording devices, including a cell phone, is not permitted in changing areas, rest rooms or locker rooms.

Operation of a drone, or any other flying apparatus, is prohibited over the venue (pools, athlete/coach areas, spectator areas and open ceiling locker rooms) any time athletes, coaches, officials and/or spectators are present.
Exceptions may be granted with prior written approval by the Vice President of Program Operations.
