CHANGES TO CHAMPIONSHIP FORMAT FOR 2024

The following outlines the changes to the current championship format, as established by the Technical Planning Committee, that will be implemented for all 2024 IASI Championship meets, unless otherwise noted.

Of note, the event offerings and order of events for the Short Course Senior Championships and all Regionals Championships will remain the same.

Additionally, the qualifying standards for all championship meets will not get slower and may get faster as deemed necessary for meeting the timeline demands for each meet. The qualifying standards used for specific events at the Regionals Championships will remain the same.

Below are changes to the format from previous championship editions:

• Limited Prelim/Final Event Offerings for 11-12 Age Group at Short Course Age Group Championships

At the Short Course Age Group Championships, all events 100-yards or shorter will be contested as prelim/final events, with the fastest eight swimmers qualifying for finals. Events 200-yards or longer will be contested as timed finals events with the eight highest seeded swimmers competing during the evening session, as done during the previous championship cycle.

Include the 100 Individual Medley for the 13-14 Age Group at the Short Course Age Group Championships

Exclusively at the Short Course Age Group Championships, the 100-yard Individual Medley will be included in the event program for the 13-14 age group on a meet day without the 200-yard or 400-yard Individual Medleys. Qualifying times will be established for the 100-yard Individual Medley when released in October 2023.

Finalist Announcements

If time permits, a short break (approximately 2-minutes) will be included following each preliminary event to announce the swimmers qualifying for finals. Should the results from the preliminary round not be ready for announcement, the swimmers qualifying for finals will be announced at the next announcement break.

Rearrange Event Order for the Short Course Age Group Championships

To accommodate the inclusion of the 13-14 100-yard Individual Medley and a limited offering of prelim/final events for the 11-12 age group, a new event order is necessary. Additionally, the new event order rearranges the Friday events to spread out the 1000 Freestyle, 200 Freestyle, and 800 Freestyle Relay. The new order of events is listed below:

Slight Event Order Rearrangement for the Long Course Championships

At the Long Course Championships, move the 13-14 and Senior 200 Breaststroke from the third day of the meet to the fourth day of the meet, situated between the 200 Backstroke and prior to the 100 Freestyle. Additionally, move the 400 Freestyle on the third day of the meet to between the 100 Backstroke and 100 Butterfly.

Additionally, there are a few concepts that the Technical Planning Committee will continue exploring and working with others around the LSC to create a plan for implementation, including but not limited to:

Enhanced Excitement at Championships Meets

In an effort to enhance the excitement at all championship meets, the Technical Planning Committee will continue to explore various areas noted to upgrade the experience for the swimmers. For example, regarding the public address announcer, would increasing the information and/or training provided create a more exciting atmosphere? Can additional signage be secured to dress the facility for the look of a top-level championship? Would switching from athlete bag tags to a gift pin be a benefit to swimmers while simplifying logistics for host clubs? The previous items and others will be continually explored and implemented in due course.

• Explore Single Age Group Qualifying Standards

As previously discussed, single age group divisions don't present an optimal situation for meet operations. However, the Technical Planning Committee will explore using single age group time standards to increase the

number of swimmers qualified to compete in the current competition structure. Essentially, single age group time standards could serve as a bonus entry method for the swimmers at the bottom of the age group. For example, the events may only differ by 0.2 per 50 for swimmers in the bottom of the age group. This will be examined as a potential option for increasing participation. Also, consider exploring the impact of a percentage change from the current standards that are slower for the bottom of the age group and faster for the top of the age group.

• Continue Reviewing the Event Offerings at Championship Meets

The Technical Planning Committee will continue to review the events offered at championship meets and strive to meet the desires of all primary stakeholder groups. Among these considerations, the inclusion of the 1500/1650 will be an area discussed.

• Examine Championship Meet Financials for Encouraging Hosts to Host

Following championship meets the financial information from the previous meets will be reviewed by members of the Technical Planning Committee to determine where changes or adjustments may be necessary, with the objective of ensuring that championship meets are well conducted and appealing to host clubs.
