### Financial Reports posted on IASI website

2024-2025 end of the fiscal year Balance Sheet

Assets: \$269,803.55 Liabilities: \$26.466.93 Equity: \$243.336.62

Restricted funds included in equities are \$26.858.28 (Scholarship fund)

# 2024-2025 Fiscal Year ending reports show a surplus of \$77,129.94

Making such a large surplus was not part of budget approved by this HOD prior to the 2024-2025 fiscal year's start

#### Largest areas of that contributed to this surplus were:

# Revenues were \$13,192.61 higher than budgeted

- Splash fees collected were \$11,511 greater than budgeted
- This is a positive surplus as it is a result of greater participation than originally projected of our LSC's membership at swim meets hosted within our LSC

### Administration staffing expense was \$39,504 less than budgeted

- Many services once provided by the IASI professional staff were not provided last year
  - The results was that LSC professional staff worked less hours than in past years
- Services not provided that were in past years included:
  - o The availability to speak to an IASI staff professional by phone was limited greatly
  - Results files from the High School Regional, District and State meets which were once prepared and distributed by the office were not done
  - The LSC's Championship Meets' Entry Time Reconciliation was not completed by the LSC's professional staff
  - A Zone Table no longer staffed by a member of IASI's professional team leading to numerous entry mistakes
    - Team lowa swimmers were left out of events and entry times were incorrectly entered
    - These types of mistakes were very rare when IASI's professional staff worked a Zone's Table at the LSC's Long Course Championships

#### Athlete Travel Reimbursement

- There was a surplus of \$4,900 in athlete travel reimbursement
  - \$13,100 of the \$18,000 budgeted was spent assisting athletes with travel cost to high level swim meets
- Total issued this summer was \$7,800
  - 2 who attended Juniors (\$750 each)
  - 4 who attended Futures (\$550 each)
  - o 7 who attended Sectionals (\$250 each)
  - 21 who attended Age Group Zones (\$150 each)

- Two athletes received reimbursement for two meets because they completed the requests correctly
