From USA Swimming Rulebook 102.2.3

In a timed finals meet, a swimmer may compete in not more than six (6) individual events per day.

From USA Swimming Rulebook 102.2.7 emphasis added...

The above limitations on individual events apply regardless of the classification mixture or if separate meets or time trials are being conducted. These, and additional limitations on entries which may be established by the LSC's sanction or approval, shall be clearly stated in the meet announcement.

From IASI Section I. IV. B.

Event Limitations. USA Swimming Rules 102.2 sets the general rules for the limitations on the number of events a swimmer may compete in per day. However, pursuant to 102.2.7, for IASI sanctioned meets, swimmers may compete in a maximum of four individual events in a session and a maximum of six individual events in a day. (Adopted 10/7/2018)

Background:

The current structure makes a single session "pentathlon" meet non-compliant with LSC sanctioning requirements

Proposal: Eliminate part of IASI Section I. IV. B to remove LSC requirements which are more restrictive than USA Swimming rules:

Event Limitations. USA Swimming Rules 102.2 sets the general rules for the limitations on the number of events a swimmer may compete in per day. However, pursuant to 102.2.7, for IASI sanctioned meets, swimmers may compete in a maximum of four individual events in a session and a maximum of six individual events in a day.

Alternative Proposal A: Amend IASI Section I. IV. B to allow 11 & Older athletes to participate in more events while maintaining the LSC restrictions on 10 & Under athletes

Event Limitations. USA Swimming Rules 102.2 sets the general rules for the limitations on the number of events a swimmer may compete in per day. However, pursuant to 102.2.7, for IASI sanctioned meets, 10 & Under swimmers may only compete in a maximum of four individual events in a session and a maximum of six individual events in a day.

Alternative Proposal B: Amend IASI Section I. IV. B to provide an exemption for Pentathlon meets

Event Limitations. USA Swimming Rules 102.2 sets the general rules for the limitations on the number of events a swimmer may compete in per day. However, pursuant to 102.2.7, for IASI sanctioned meets, swimmers may compete in a maximum of four individual events in a session and a maximum of six individual events in a day. This limitation will not apply to pentathlon meets where a swimmer swims five events in a single session as the events are 1 each Breaststroke, Backstroke, Butterfly, Freestyle, and Individual Medley.
