I. Call to Order:

II. Review of Business:

Sarah Landreneau will work on housing, travel and scheduling. The HPC was held at St. Martins this year. St, Martins was paid \$1,600.00 for hosting the Camp. Ross Hedrick questioned the idea of moving the HOD Saturday meeting to Sunday. The change would need a vote taken at the HOD meeting.

Marie Landreneau and the athletes set up a canned food drive to begin 1 October through 1 November. The food will be delivered to the food bank of choice by each team. Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 teams bringing in the greatest number of canned goods.

John Janszen reported that teams should be able to apply for **Safe Sport** by November.
