The Age Group Committee Chair shall assume office on September 1<sup>st</sup> following the election of the General Chair, or upon appointment if appointed after September 1<sup>st</sup>, and shall serve until August 31<sup>st</sup> following the next election of the General Chair.

## JOB REQUIREMENTS & RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Attend and participate in all Board of Directors and House of Delegates Meetings.
- 2. Chair the Age Group Committee.
  - a) Attend and lead all meetings.
  - b) Create, review, and approve the meeting agenda in advance.
    - i) Ordinarily, meetings should be held monthly; however, more frequent meetings may be necessary to meet the needs of the LSC.
  - c) Support focused dialogue and decision making.
  - d) Ensure the Committee designates a Committee Secretary to take meeting minutes and submit all reports.
  - e) Oversee all aspects of Age Group swimming within the LSC.
    - i) Develop and conduct Age Group programming that aligns with the LSC's mission to "Provide opportunities for all to achieve their highest potential in competitive swimming."
    - ii) Create opportunities that foster age group development, including camps and clinics.
    - iii) Assist in facilitating all All-Star team events.
    - iv) Develop time standards for all Age Group meets within the NES Championship meet progression.
    - v) Manage all Age Group meets within the NES Championship meet progression, including meet formats and awards.
    - vi) Evaluate all Age Group meets within the NES Championship meet progression.
  - f) Solicit feedback from all members of the LSC who are involved with Age Group swimming.
  - g) Coordinate and collaborate with committee members to achieve the LSC Strategic Plan.
- 3. Respond to all inquiries and communications from the NES Office, Board of Directors, Committee members, and the general membership in a timely manner.
- 4. Serve and actively participate as a member of the Calendar Committee and Zone Committee.
- 5. Attend all USA Swimming workshops and meetings as deemed appropriate and necessary by the LSC.
- 6. Perform all duties in a professional manner that coincides with and represents the New England Swimming mission to: "Provide opportunities for all to achieve their highest potential in competitive swimming."
